Action Items: The School Board took action to approve the Consent Agenda that included minutes from April 8th and April 22nd Board Meetings and most recent Gifts to the District.

The Board also approved the selection of Mr.

A leave of absence request for 2015-16 for Hucrest Teacher Jana Gore was approved as well.

The Board accepted the resignation for the purpose of retirement of Mr. James Schvaneveldt, 2nd Grade Teacher at Melrose Elementary after 24 years of service.

The Board awarded the E-Rate bid for Wireless Access Points to CDWg.

The staff recommendation to purchase 101 Mac Minis to replace outdated equipment in computer labs at both middle schools and the high school was reviewed and approved.

The Phoenix Charter School Renewal Contract and Appendices, effective July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2020, were reviewed and approved.

A revised 2015-2016 Calendar of School Board Meetings was also approved.

Board Policy DN: Disposal of District Property, was approved for First Reading.

New Policy LBEA: Resident Student Denial for Virtual Charter School Attendance, was approved for First Reading.

Roseburg High School Student Representative:

RHS approved their new mission statement, "RHS: A place of opportunity to attain knowledge and become productive, independent citizens who live PRIDE."
