Report: Superintendent Washburn reported that our telephone system issues appear to be resolved. He thanked Physical Plant Manager, Tracy Grauf, for his expertise in expediting resolution of the RHS Gym floor issues. Administration is working on the 2016-17 budget, considering expected revenues, declining Title 1 funding and student behavior needs. In preparation for the mascot MOU with the Cow Creek Band of Umpqua Tribe of Indians, he met with families of Native American students who were supportive of the district retaining our mascot. Principal, Katrina Hanson, gave a warm welcome to the members of the Board and audience. Students had prepared colorful posters for presentation to the Board. Katrina shared that the culture of Fullerton IV. benefits from a great Booster Club, dedicated staff, a positive PBIS presence and OSU staff providing science opportunities for the kids.

Action Items:

The School Board approved the Consent Agenda that included minutes from the February 10th Regular

Board Meeting; Gifts to the District; a current listing of Surplus items; and a recommendation to employ Lisa Lanza, RHS Odyssey-Ware Teacher and Shirley Thomas, RHS Special Education Teacher. Both positions are temporary for the remainder of the 2015-16 school year. A resignation was accepted from Fremont Middle School TAP Room Teacher, Lance Lane, after two years with the District.

In adopting Resolution 15-16-12, the Board approved the week of March 7-11, 2016 as Classified Employee Appreciation Week.

Policy INDB: Flag Displays & Salutes, was approved for 2nd Reading and Adoption.

The Board also approved renewals of Probationary Administrator Contracts; Probationary Teachers First to Second Year, Second Year to Contract and Third Year to Contract. Contract Administrator Three-Year Extensions, Two-Year Extensions; Temporary Teacher Renewals; Licensed Staff on Unpaid Leave of Absence; Expiration of Temporary and Non-renewed Teacher Contracts and a List of Resignations were also approved. The Chief Operations Officer Contract was also renewed through the 2017-2018 school year.

Open Enrollment Law:

The Board acted to approve that through the mutual agreement between districts process, the District will accept non-resident students who

apply to Roseburg Public Schools, and will release resident students who apply to attend another school district for the 2016—2017 school year.

Report: Student leadership representative Samantha Bergmann is a RHS Freshman involved in volleyball, basketball and softball. RHS Senior, Fallon Peters, is a member of the bowling team and honor society. These Leadership students reported recent sports results in swimming, bowling and wrestling. Students are excited at the prospect of attending The Ashland Shakespearean Festival and seeing an amazing play. Smarter Balanced assessments are in progress.
