Action Items: The Board approved the Consent Agenda that included minutes from the March 16th Regular Board Meeting and Executive Session; a recommendation to employ Robert Emerson, Director of Teaching &

Learning; Randal Olsen, Alternative Education Coordinator; Amy Jo Rodriguez, Green School Principal; Yvonne O'Neil, Fullerton IV Kindergarten Teacher; Jennifer Steinacher, Melrose Kindergarten Teacher; and John "Ira" Wier, Science Teacher at Roseburg High School.

Resignations were accepted from Denise Brausam, Special Education Teacher at Sunnyslope after 30 years with the district, and Jacqueline Peterson, English Language Learner Teacher, after nine years with the district, for the purpose of retirement at the end of the 2015-16 school year. Resignations were also accepted from Brittany Jacobberger, Eastwood Kindergarten Teacher after one year; Mariah O'Connor, RHS Language Arts Teacher; and Rebecca Tillett, Melrose Kindergarten Teacher after ten years with the District.

The Board also approved a request for unpaid Leave of Absence for classified staff member Kim Hall, Melrose Instructional Assistant, for the remainder of the 2015-16 school year.

Resolution 15-16-14 Declaring the week of May 2-6, 2016 as Teacher Appreciation Week was adopted.

Policy IKF: Graduation Requirements, was approved for First Reading.

The Board directed Cheryl Northam to publish a Notice of Intent to Award for RFP 15-626 Pupil Transportation to First Student, Inc. Chair Cotton thanked representatives from Durham Transportation for their many years of

dedicated service to Roseburg Public Schools.

The Board also directed that a Notice of Intent to Award be published for RFP 16-630 Audit Services, to the firm of Kosmatka, Donnelly & Piels.
