The Board approved the nutrition services contract extension with Sodexo America, LLC, for 2016-2017.

Superintendent Washburn's contract extension was approved effective July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2019.

New Policy GCBDD/GDBDD: Sick Time for Non-Union and LBE-AR: Employees; Public Charter Schools, were both approved for 1st Reading.

The proposed 2017-18 school year calendar was adopted. The Board noted that RHS Graduation will be held on Saturday, June 9, 2018.

Middle School Social Science posal to continue using ComSpan as the district's telephone service provider. Subject to E-Rate funding, the Board also approved the purchase of new Cisco switches from CDW-G once funds become available through the USAC E-Rate program.
