Superintendent's Report:

Dr. Washburn plans to schedule an Executive Session in January to review superintendent goals with the Board. We have applied for a Ford Foundation grant to expand pre-school offerings to an afternoon class at Green Elementary. We continue to move forward with a larger proposal to partner with Head Start to offer pre-school in all of our Title 1 schools. Many principals, office managers and CDS staff

Board members were honored to recognize three Student of the Month recipients, Madison Juett, a Hucrest Elementary Fifth Grade student; Oscar Stribling, a Fir Grove Elementary Fifth Grade Student; and Garrett Zeimet, an Eighth Grade Fremont Middle School student. Staff Recognition:

Eileen Stanton, RHS Math Teacher, was presented with the Crystal Apple Award in recognition of her highly skilled instruction to both students and fellow teachers.

Action Items:

The Board approved the Consent Agenda

including November 16th Minutes; Gifts to the District and a list of Surplus Items.

The Board approved the recommendation to hire Sara Wells, Kindergarten Teacher, a temporary position for the 2016-2017 school year (this had formerly been approved as a job share).

The Board entered into a Local Review Board Hearing, and after review of the findings of fact, approved the use of the CM/GC method of contracting for the Green Elementary School seismic upgrades. This is similar to the process used during the construction project at Roseburg High School a few years ago. Administration will now proceed with the request for contractor proposals.

A Motion to approve Resolution 16-17-12 adopting the OSBA 2017-18 Legislative Priorities and Policies as recommended by the OSBA Legislative Policy Committee failed for lack of a second.

Revised Policy GBA: Equal Employment Opportunity, was also approved for Second Reading and Adoption.

Student leadership representatives including Natalie Lehrbach, Bella Frasnelly and Carolyn Culty reported on recent winter sports results and student volunteer activities. Leadership has decorated the school for the holidays, and individual compliments for every student were created and will be posted on student lockers prior to their return from winter break.
