Superintendent's
Report:

Dr. Washburn confirmed that the work group for informing the Budget Committee work on the 2017-18 budget will convene in February. Both the budget and negotiations calendars could be impacted if the legislature delays adopting their budget. A \$25,000 Ford Family Foundation grant was received to expand the Pre-K program at Green. Stewart Parkway is scheduled to be closed for 90 days and

we will work to develop alternate bus routes as needed. Staff will be attending the January 30th "I Love U Guys" training as part of our School Crisis Plan.

Superintendent Washburn reported resignations from Fremont Middle School Teachers, Brandan Bigos, Special Education, and Michael Williams, Social Studies. We also received notice of intent to retire at the end of the school year from Pat Pecorilla, Kindergarten Teacher at Fullerton IV. Mr. Washburn shared that it has been a pleasure working with Pat, who was very professional in performing her duties as union president for licensed staff.

Student Recognition:

Board members were honored to recognize two Student of the Month recipients; Mayson Heuberger, a Green Elementary 5th Grade student, and Ella McDonald, a 5th Grade Student at Hucrest Elementary. The honorees received a congratulatory letter from their school principal as well as gift certificates from McDonalds.

Staff Recognition:

The Crystal Apple Award was presented to Hucrest Elementary's Melissa "Missey" Denzer, who was honored for her "I can do that" attitude in helping all students connect to the school.

Action Items:

The Board approved the Consent Agenda that included minutes from January 11 and Leave of Absence Requests for RHS employee, Alice Frerichs, and Fullerton IV employee, Rebecca Hurley.

The District requested proposals for contract manager/general contractor (CM/GC) services for the Green Elementary Seismic Rehabilitation project on December 16, 2016. The Building & Sites Committee met on January 18th to review and score submitted proposals. After interviewing representatives from both Chambers Construction and Adroit Construction, the review committee recommended the Board accept the proposal from Adroit Construction. The Board approved the recommendation to appoint Adroit as the CM/GC for the Green Seismic Project.

New course offerings were approved for RHS.

The 2017-2018 Budget Calendar was adopted.

The Healthy and Safe Schools Plan was reviewed and approved for First Reading.
