Action Items:

The Board approved the Consent Agenda including October 26th Minutes; Gifts to the District and a listing of Surplus Items.

The Board approved recommendations to hire Shonna Barry, Special Education, Language Arts Teacher at RHS; Arryn Bess, Elementary Music Teacher; Anela Plunkett, School Psychologist; and two job share temporary

Kindergarten Teachers, Jan Fullerton and Sara Wells.

The 2016-2017 Service Provider Agreement between Umpqua Community College (UCC) and the District was also approved.

The Board approved the proposal to move forward with the purchase of a cloud-based student information data system. Schoolzilla is a K-12 data platform that will provide customizable dashboards to enable educators and leaders to save time, gain critical insights and improve student outcomes through data-driven decisions.

Revised Policy GBA: Equal Employment Opportunity, was approved for First Reading.

The Board reviewed the draft Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Cow Creek Band of Umpqua Tribe of Indians regarding the high school mascot. Suggestions will be shared with tribal leadership

as we continue to move forward with this mutual agreement.

RHS Student Leadership Report:

Student leadership representatives, Jessica Grubbs, Marinda Carlyle and Gretchen Lucido reported on activities, including recycling, and noted that fall sports just finished up and winter sports began Monday. Swimming and Softball teams will have new coaches this year. Leadership students attended a Seaside conference and brought back innovative ideas that were put into action immediately.
