Instructors expressed concern regarding time spent away from classrooms for training, and the need for professional development to be tailored to individual growth.

Lawless Roofing was awarded the bid to re-roof the Winchester Elementary gymnasium and cafeteria. These repairs will be performed as weather permits.

The Board awarded a bid to ZCS Engineering firm for engineering services for the Green Elementary Seismic Rehabilitation project.

Resolution 16-17-11: Designating the week of November 14-18, 2016, as American Education Week was also adopted.

Policy BBC: Board Member Resignations, was approved for 2nd Reading and Adoption.
