The School Board approved a proposed request for Leave of Absence for RHS Skills Trainer, Heath Howington for the remainder of the 2017-2018 school year.

The Middle School Boundary Committee recommendation to adjust the boundaries of Joseph Lane and Fremont Middle Schools to eliminate the split attendance zones at Melrose and Eastwood Elementary Schools was approved.

Policy EEAE: Student Transportation in Private Vehicles, was approved for 2nd Reading and Adoption.

Policy IKF-AR: Graduation Requirements, was approved for First Reading.

In approving Resolution 17-18-17, the Board joined others nationwide in designating the week of May 7-11, 2018 as National Teacher Appreciation Week.

The Board approved the Pilot Program Team recommendation to adopt the McGraw Hill Wonders K-5 Elementary Language Arts curriculum effective with the 2018-19 school year, at an estimated cost of \$629,749.00.

The Board directed the District to publish a Notice of Intent to Award a Contract for an estimated \$518,700 for Artificial Turf Replacement to Hellas Construction, Inc.
