Superintendent's Report:

Dr. Washburn attended the AASA convention joining with the Oregon Executive Council, taking the opportunity to attend valuable presentations on the pace of student instruction and longitudinal study results impacted by effects of students in poverty. The Superintendent and high school principal recently addressed this year's Project Leadership Team. Action Items: The Board approved the Consent Agenda that consisted of Minutes from January 24, 2018, Gifts to the District and Surplus Items. The recommendations to hire Richard Snyder as Principal of Winchester Elementary, and Angela Chenoweth, Agricultural Science Teacher at RHS, a temporary position for 2017-18 were approved. Director Freeman acknowledged retired Principal Keith Kronser for filling in as Principal at Winchester School through February.

Dr. Washburn announced resignations effective at the conclusion of the 2017-18 school year, including Patsy Meeker, Third Grade Teacher at Green; Vicki Pennington, First

Grade Teacher at Winchester; Judy Royce, Second Grade Teacher at Fullerton IV; and Kelly Rush, Alternative Ed Teacher. Lindsey Wilson, RHS Agricultural Science Teacher, has resigned effective February 15th, and Anela Plunkett, a School Psychologist, is resigning effective April 17th.

We are joining other school districts and the American School Bus Council in declaring February as "Love the Bus Month". Dozens of local bus drivers arise before sunrise to transport children safely to school.

The Board appointed Bonnie Dauterman as the newest member of our Budget Committee.

The Board approved the mutual agreement between districts process, whereas the District will accept non-resident students who apply to Roseburg Public Schools and will release resident students who apply to attend another school district for the 2018-2019 school year.

Newly recommended course offerings for RHS were approved for the 2018-19 school year.

Policy IGBAK: Special Education - Public Availability of State Application, was approved for First Reading.
