The June 13th School Board Meeting was held at 6:00 p.m. in the Administrative Office Board Room located at 1419 NW Valley View Drive, Roseburg, Oregon.

Superintendent's Report:

Dr. Washburn presented May student enrollment data, noting that this year we graduated a smaller senior class, with next year's coming in with 64 more students than the class of 2018. This year's total enrollment ended with 5,884 students, an increase of 42 over last year. The Superintendent shared very encouraging preliminary SBAC student assessment data, reporting that nearly all grades have experienced increases in proficiency levels. The i-Ready program and flexibility in grouping the

students for instruction, along with Title 1 teachers providing direct student instruction rather than using a coaching model appears to be having a positive impact.

The Board acknowledged resignations from licensed staff members including:

- Angela Keeran, Special Education Teacher, after four years with the District to accept a position with Douglas ESD;
- Mark McLaughlin, RHS Social Studies Teacher, retiring after 34 years in the District; and
- Tyree Norman, Fourth Grade Teacher at Fir Grove Elementary, after two years in the District.

Action Items:

The Consent Agenda consisting of the Minutes from April 25, 2018, and Gifts to the District were approved. Human Resources Director, Robert Freeman, presented ten hiring recommendations for the 2018-2019 school year that were also approved including:

- Trevor Lavery-Thompson, Music Teacher at Joseph Lane Middle School;
- Michael MacLean, Choir Teacher at Joseph Lane Middle School;
- Annette McFadzen, Language Arts Teacher at Rose School;
- Sean Shea, Music Teacher at Green and Sunnyslope Elementary Schools; and
- Kaylee Tharp, Second Grade Teacher at Winchester Elementary School.

The School Board reluctantly accepted the resignation of Daniel Endicott, expressing their appreciation for his dedication to students and contributions as a member of the Board since 2010. The Board also then declared a vacancy for Board Position No. 2.

Resolution 17-18-18: Authorizing Budget Appropriation Transfers for 2017-2018 was approved.

Resolution 17-18-19: Adopting the 2018-2019 Budget in the total sum of \$92,446,995 and Making Appropriations and Levying Ad Valorem Taxes was approved.

An updated listing of student fees effective beginning with the 2018-2019 school year was reviewed and approved by the Board.

In line with the recently ratified licensed contract, the Board approved the District's request to approve similar COLA, insurance benefit and opt-out amounts for those who qualify effective July 1, 2018 and ending June 30, 2021 for the Administrative, Managers, Supervisors and Confidential employee groups.
