Superintendent's Report:

Dr. Washburn shared positive enrollment numbers, cautioning that secondary numbers have historically decreased during the school year. Next month, all district leadership staff will be participating in a Table Top earthquake exercise focusing on reunification following any event that would require abandonment of a school. This is the next step in the work begun last year by Nicki Opp, Eastwood Principal, in coordinating with the Fairgrounds to designate that site as an emergency reunification area.

The Board approved the purchase of the \$52,464 i-Ready Math and Reading Instruction program.

Robert Emerson and Robert Freeman have begun establishing two committees consisting of principals, staff and community members who will be tasked with a review of our school boundaries and school start times.
