Superintendent's Report:

Superintendent Lee Paterson complimented the Board for their management of the superintendent search, and shared appreciation of the opportunity to meet with the candidates. He is confident that the Board's selection will be an individual that the entire community can embrace. The Board received a copy of the upcoming Parent Survey that is part of our Continuous Improvement Plan. Chair Garcia met with Lee this week to review remaining tasks to be completed before the conclusion of Lee's contract. Lee assured the Board of his intent to work hard during his remaining term, and promised to include the incoming superintendent in discussions or recommendations that the Board may consider.

The Board approved the Consent Agenda including March 13th Minutes and Gifts to the District. Approved recommendations for hire included the following:

The Board also approved the following purchases:

- ◆ zSpace Virtual Reality Lab at RHS, in the amount of \$465,161 made possible through Measure 98 funding; and
- ◆ CTL Corporation in the amount of \$79,420 for 361 Chromebooks and associated licenses for deployment to students at Roseburg High School.

The Board was very excited to support the establishment of the virtual reality lab that has the potential to benefit numerous programs at RHS.

RHS Student Leadership:

RHS Student Leadership students, Freshman Marin Gray and Junior Mikayla Sanguins shared current student activities including preparations for Mr. RHS and plans for Homegoing events including a staff lip sync battle and assembly. RHS accreditation work will occur Thursday and Friday with evaluators observing classrooms and talking with students. Marin shared recent FBLA, math and Miss Douglas County competition results, noting that Roseburg students made us proud. Mikayla reviewed the latest sports results, noting that many events have been delayed due to weather. She also thanked the Board for giving students the opportunity to meet with the superintendent candidates, sharing that any one of those individuals would have performed well in the position.
