Superintendent's Report:

Superintendent Paterson was excused for a scheduled vacation. As Acting Superintendent, HR Director Robert Freeman publicly acknowledged the maintenance/custodial staff for preparing school facilities for the return of staff and students following the recent storm. The District's Technology Coordinator, Gary McFarlane and Payroll Specialist, Celeste Etchevery ensured that payroll deadlines were met to avoid any delays in staff receiving paychecks on time. Mr. Freeman thanked the Board for their guidance in considering both staff/students and our community in revising the 2018-19 school calendar. The budget document that will be presented to the Budget Committee on April 10th will

reflect top priorities as identified by school administrators who participated in the PLC process led by Teaching and Learning staff.

Both Mr. Freeman and Board Director Micki Hall attended the Fifth Grade play at Green Elementary, *Pirate Boys and Dragon Girl* which involved each student in that grade. Director Hall acknowledged the program's creator, Green Teacher Karen Sinclair, for writing the play and songs, which were all enjoyed by the entire school. An obvious sense of belonging is apparent in the school's culture and is to be admired.

Director Steve Patterson also recognized administrators who are helping students with reading via Facebook.

Action Items: The Board approved the Consent Agenda including Minutes from the February 13 and March 6, 2019 School Board Meetings, along with notices of upcoming licensed staff retirements and resignations.

The Board has directed the District administration to move forward with negotiating a contract with S&B James Construction for CM/GC services for the Hucrest and Melrose School seismic rehabilitation projects.

Bid awards were also approved as follows:

- ♦ Ednetics, Inc.: \$89,301 for the purchase of Cisco wireless access points; and
- ♦ Function 5 Technology: \$59,410 for Cisco network switches once funding becomes available through the USAC E-Rate program.

The Board approved the recommendations to approve renewal of Probationary Administrator Contracts; Contract Administrators Three-Year Extensions 2019-2020, 2020-2021, 2021-2022; Renewal of Probationary Teacher Contracts—First Year to Second; Second Year to Third; Third Year to Contract; and Probationary and Second year to Contract, and Contract Teachers Two-Year Extensions 2019-2020, 2020-2021. Teachers not returning due to resignations

or retirements effective at the conclusion of the 2018-2019 school year, and temporary positions expiring at the end of 2018-2019 were also accepted.

Plans continue for Mr. RHS and home-going activities. The Arts Assembly was a huge success and the drama department presented an excellent Celebration of Literacy program.
