Public Update of the 2019-2020 District Continuous Improvement Plan

District Teaching & Learning Director, Michelle Knee, shared the proposed 2019-20 Continuous Improvement Plan (CIP) in advance of the submission to the Oregon Dept. of Education. A Needs Assessment began in January to develop goals specific to Reading, Math, and Instructional and Leadership Capacity. A three-year plan has been developed and will be progress monitored.

<u>Telephone System</u> <u>Upgrade:</u>

Black Box Corp. will upgrade the District's phone system at a cost of \$66,425 migrating to the NEC SV9300 platform.

Non-Resident Student Requests for Transfer into Roseburg High School

The Board approved a revised language proposal providing for an interdistrict student transfer timeline for the 2019 -2020 school year for late transfers into RHS. This change will not impact hardship requests. Transfer requests initiated after the beginning of the school year

will now be considered in December/January for entry beginning second semester. This change will allow students, their families and the counseling staff adequate opportunity to successfully transition students into the processes, culture and schedules at RHS.

Student Leadership Report

RHS students Chelsea Miller and Alema Norris reported on activities at RHS, sharing that Homecoming was a sellout and seniors won the Powderpuff game. There was a great turnout for the Unified Partners Club Haunted House fundraiser. College Night is coming up along with Military Career Night on Nov. 5th.
