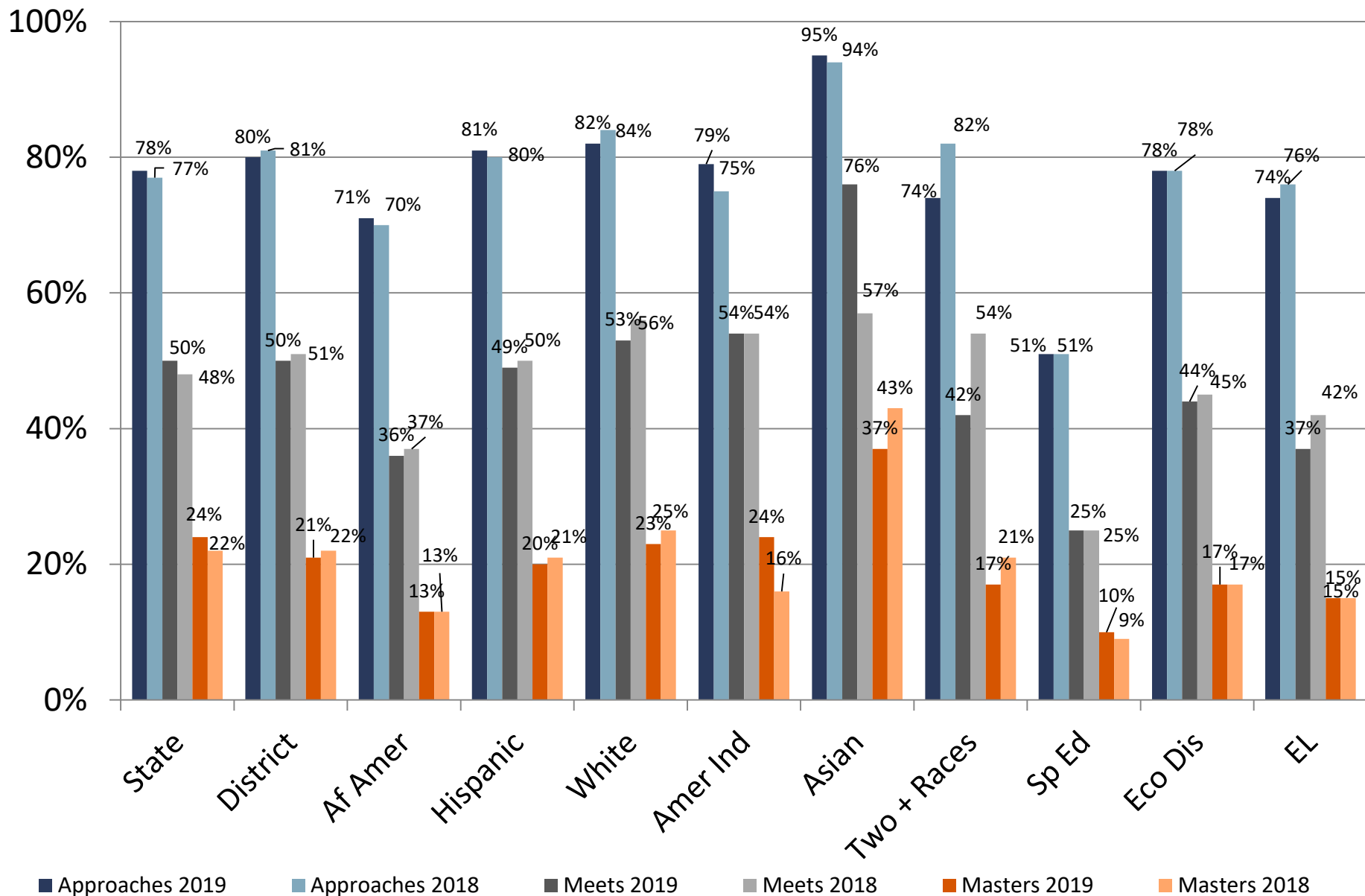

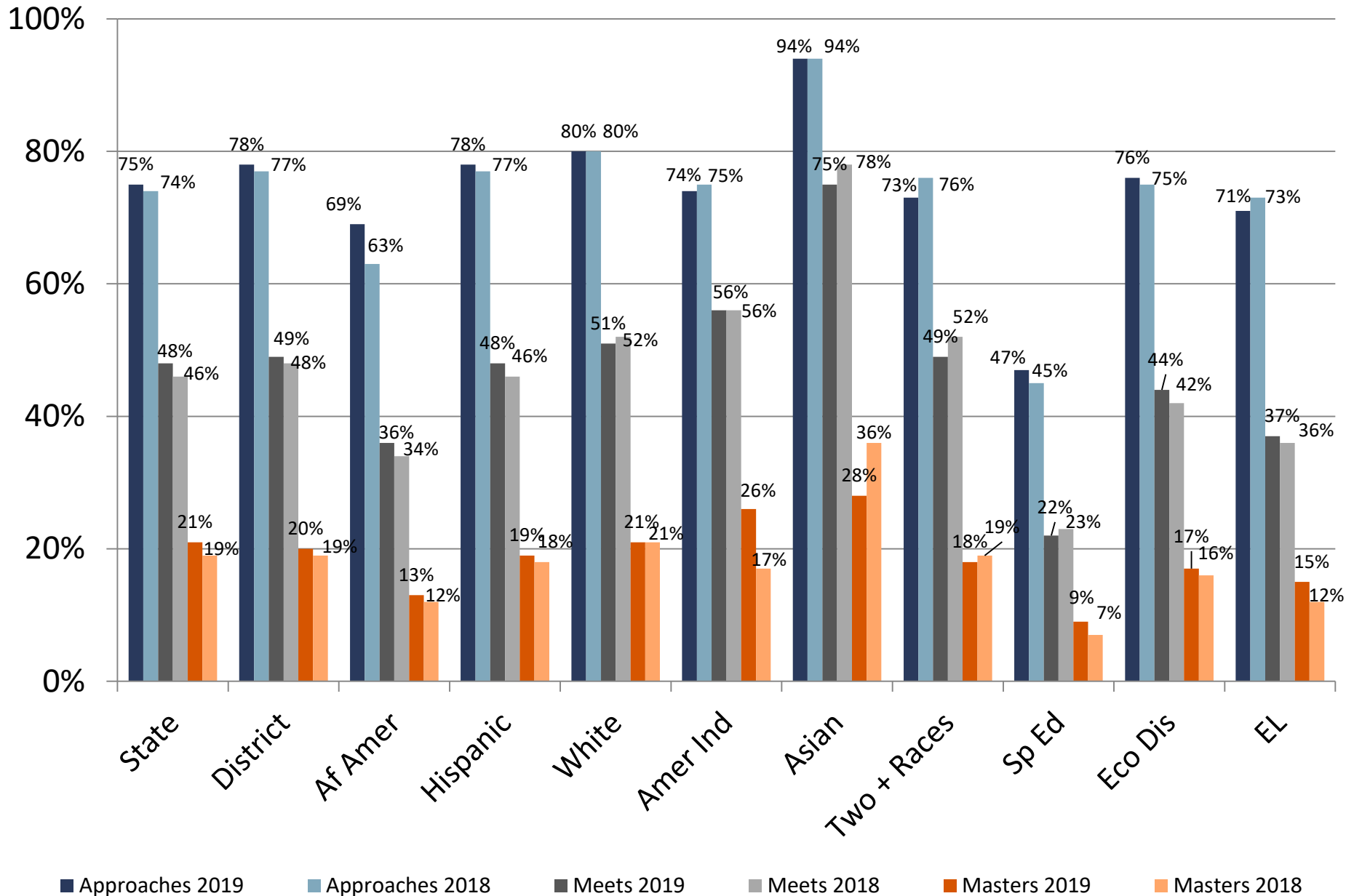

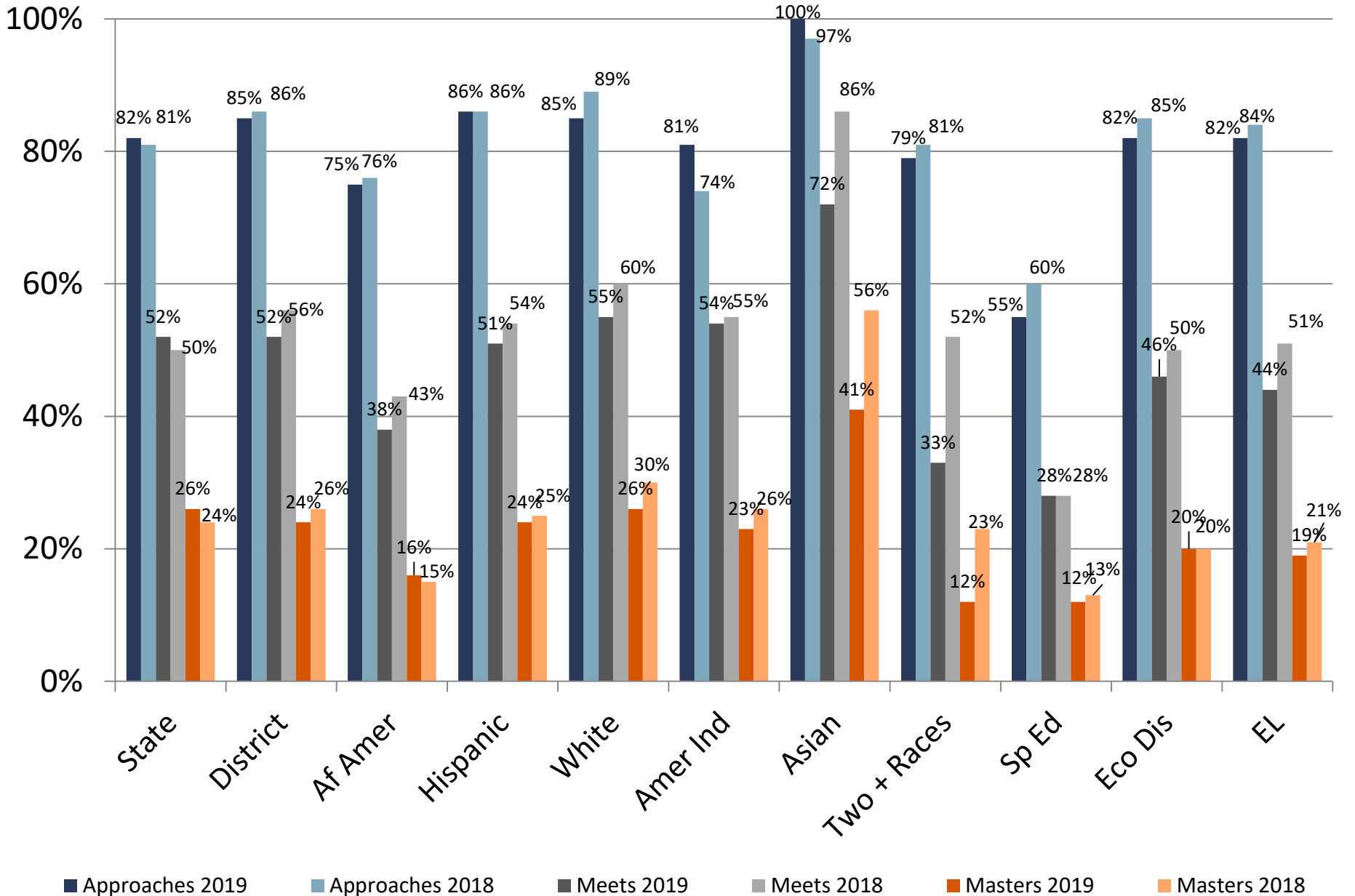
STAAR Performance: All Grades All Subjects



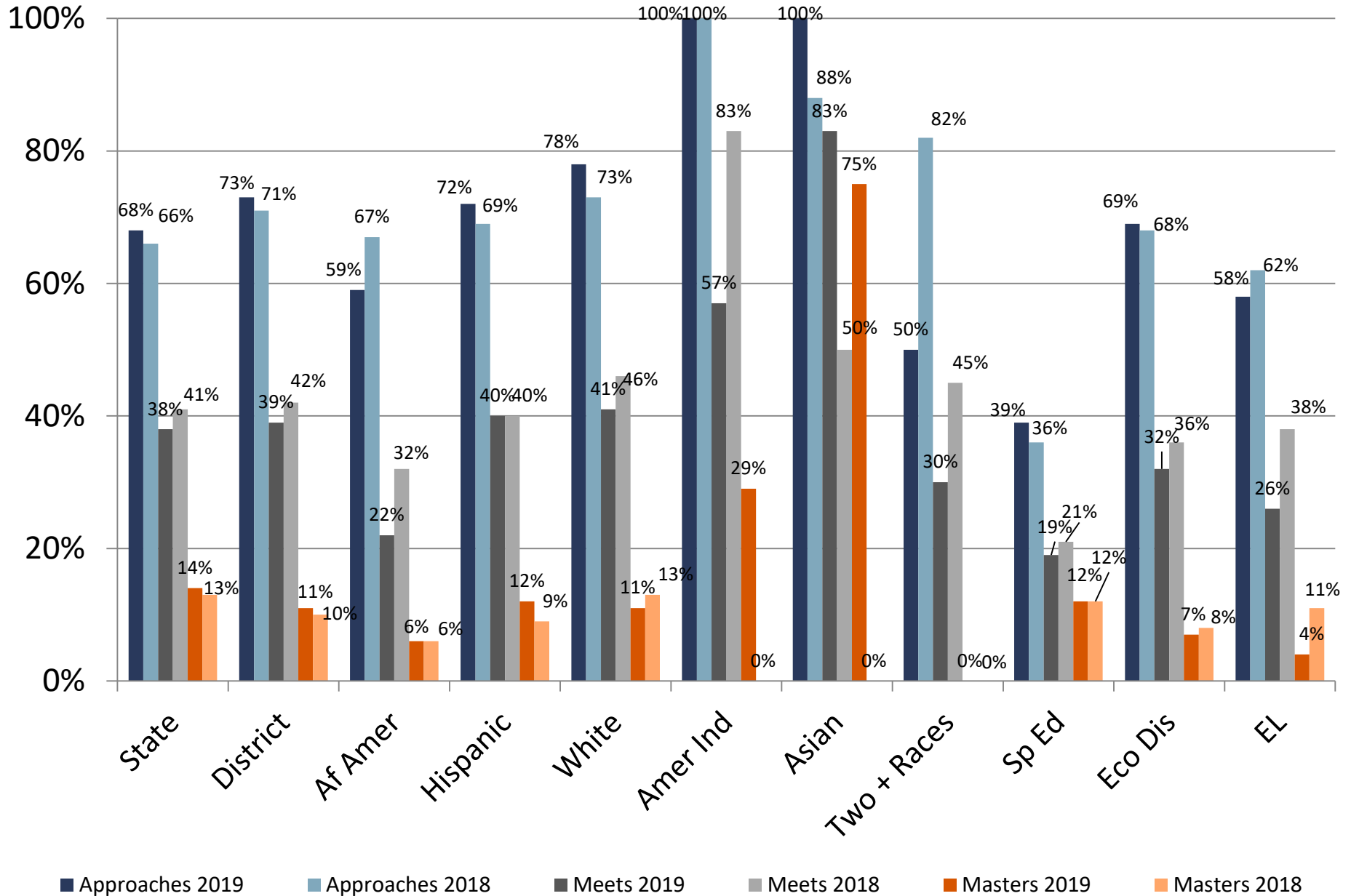
STAAR Performance: All Grades ELA/Reading



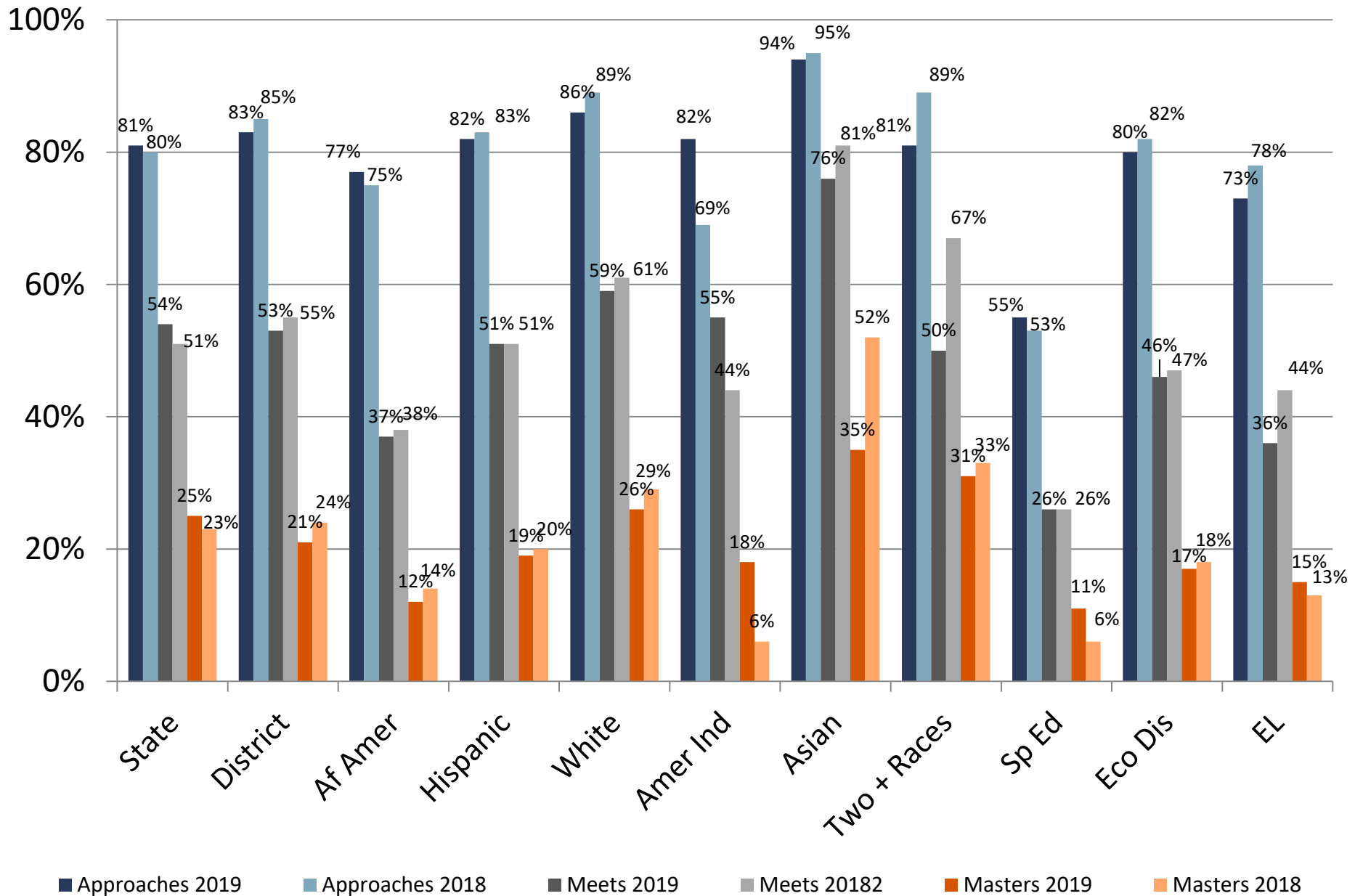
STAAR Performance: All Grades Mathematics



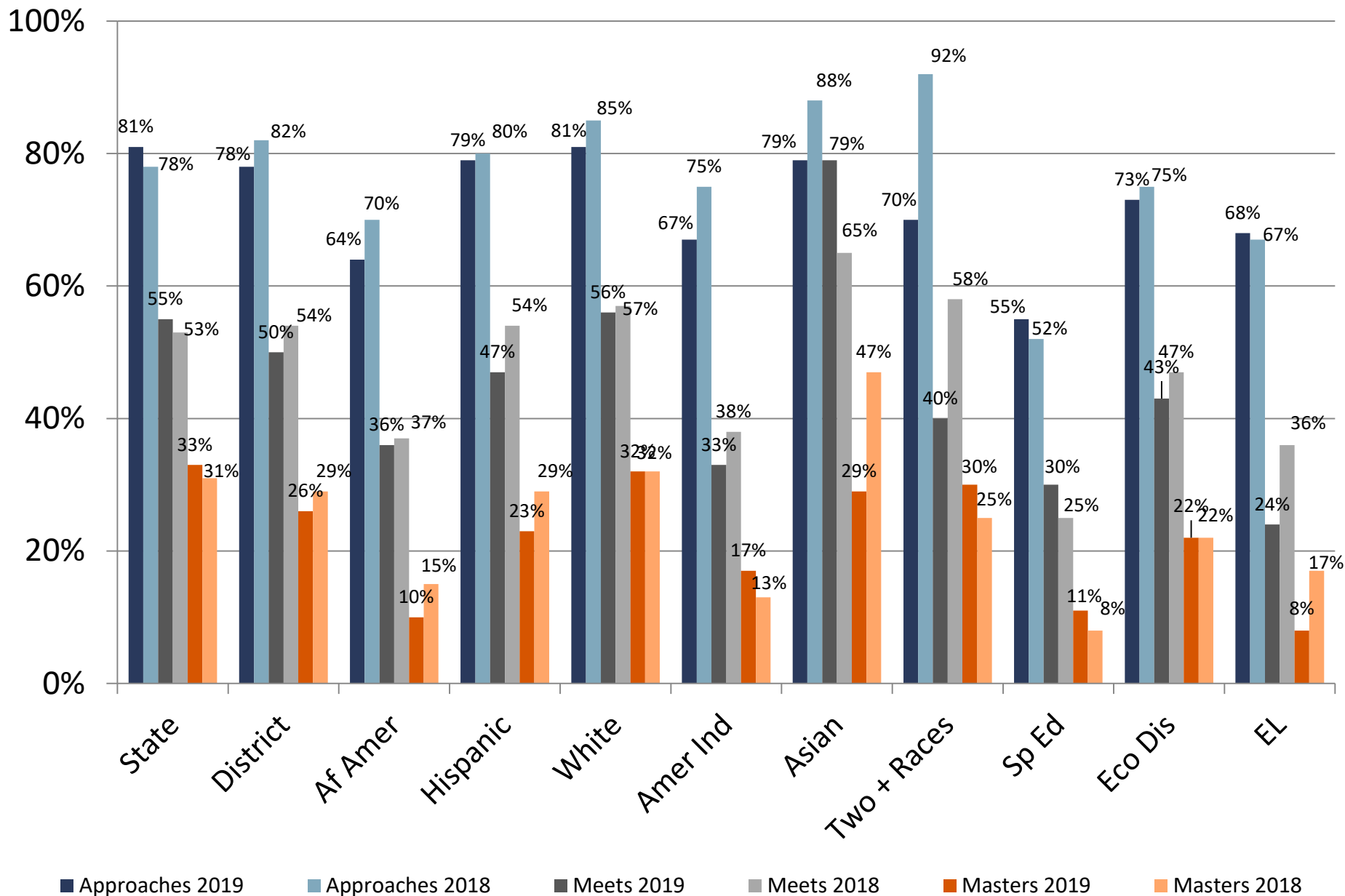
STAAR Performance: All Grades Writing

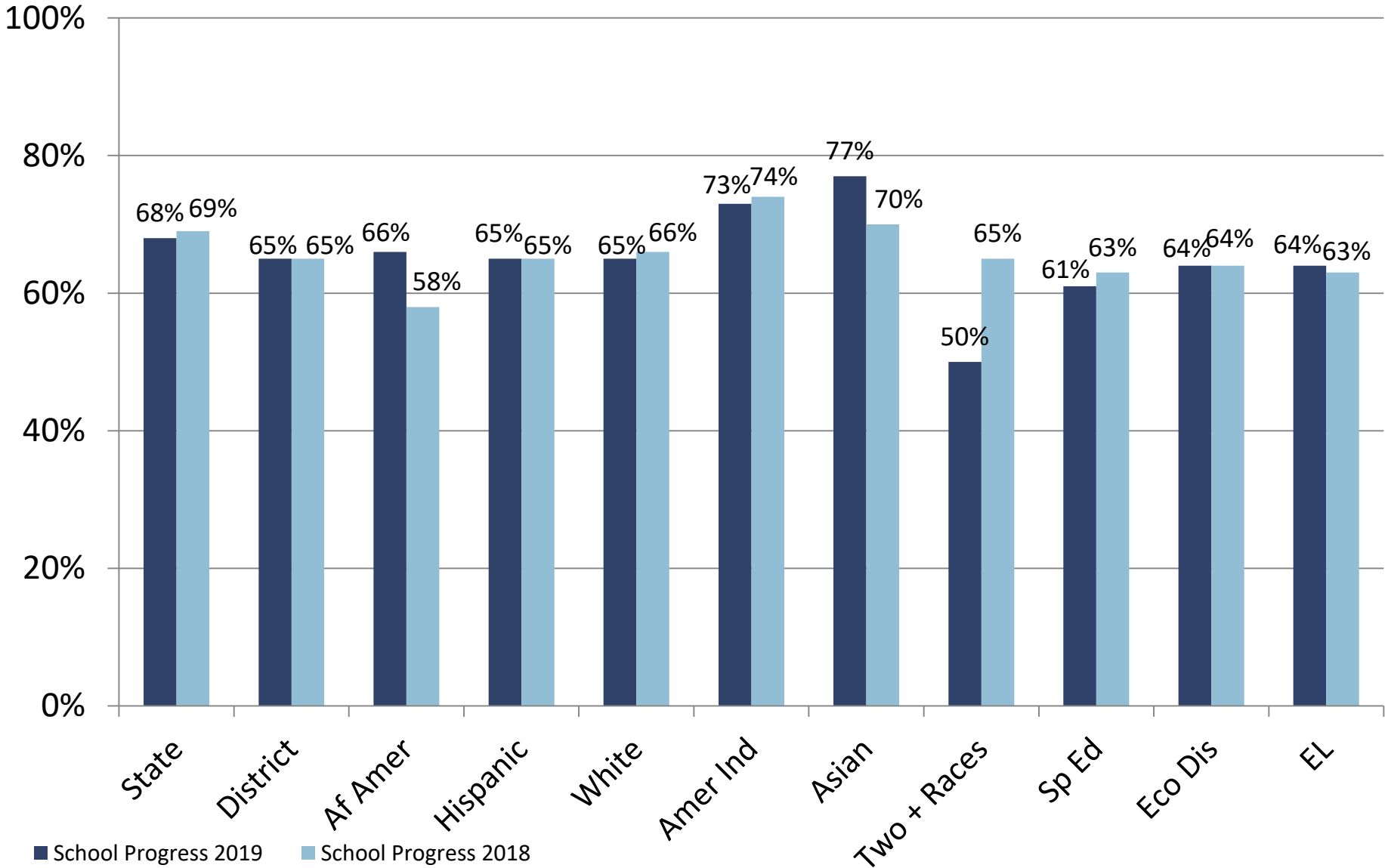

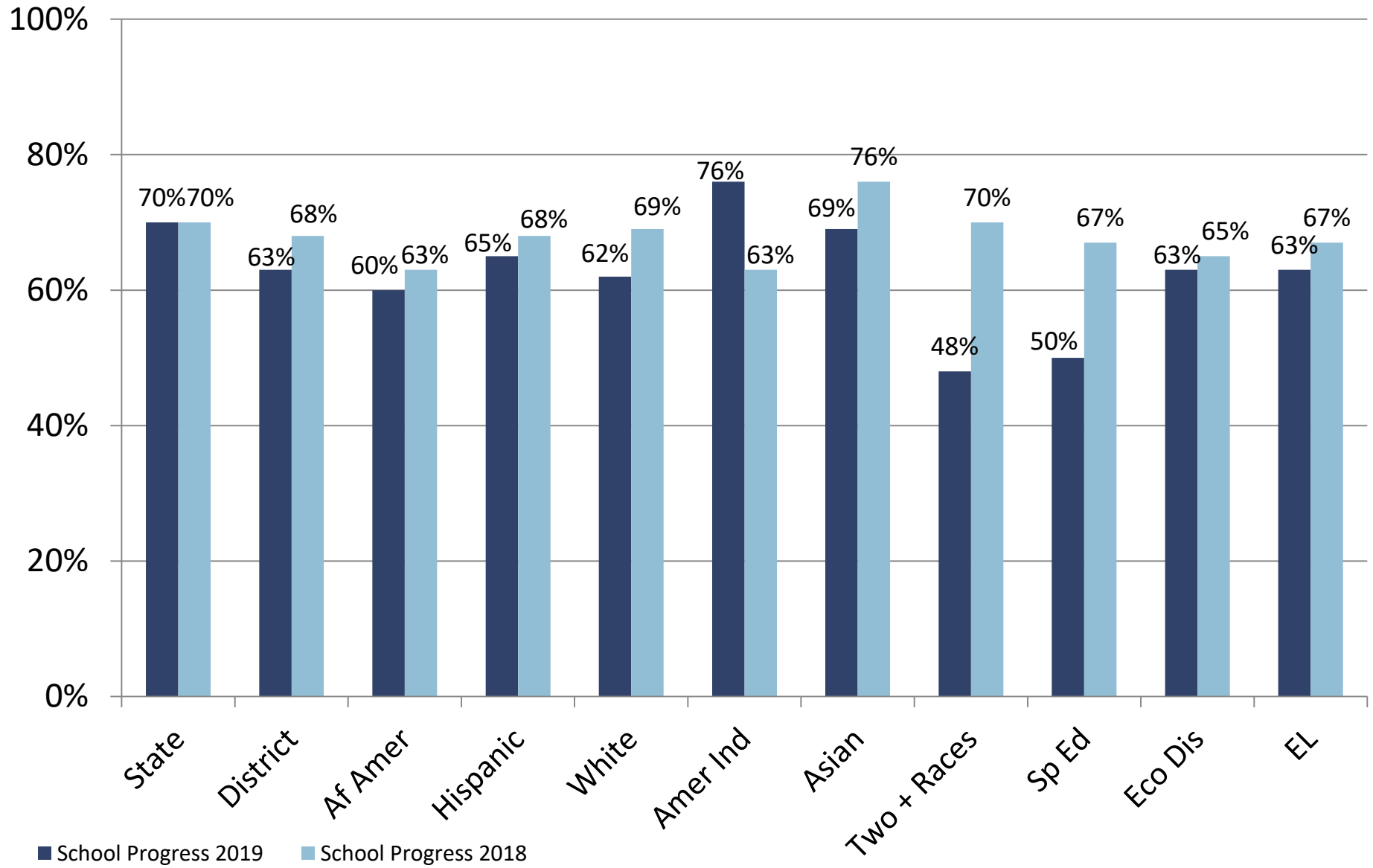

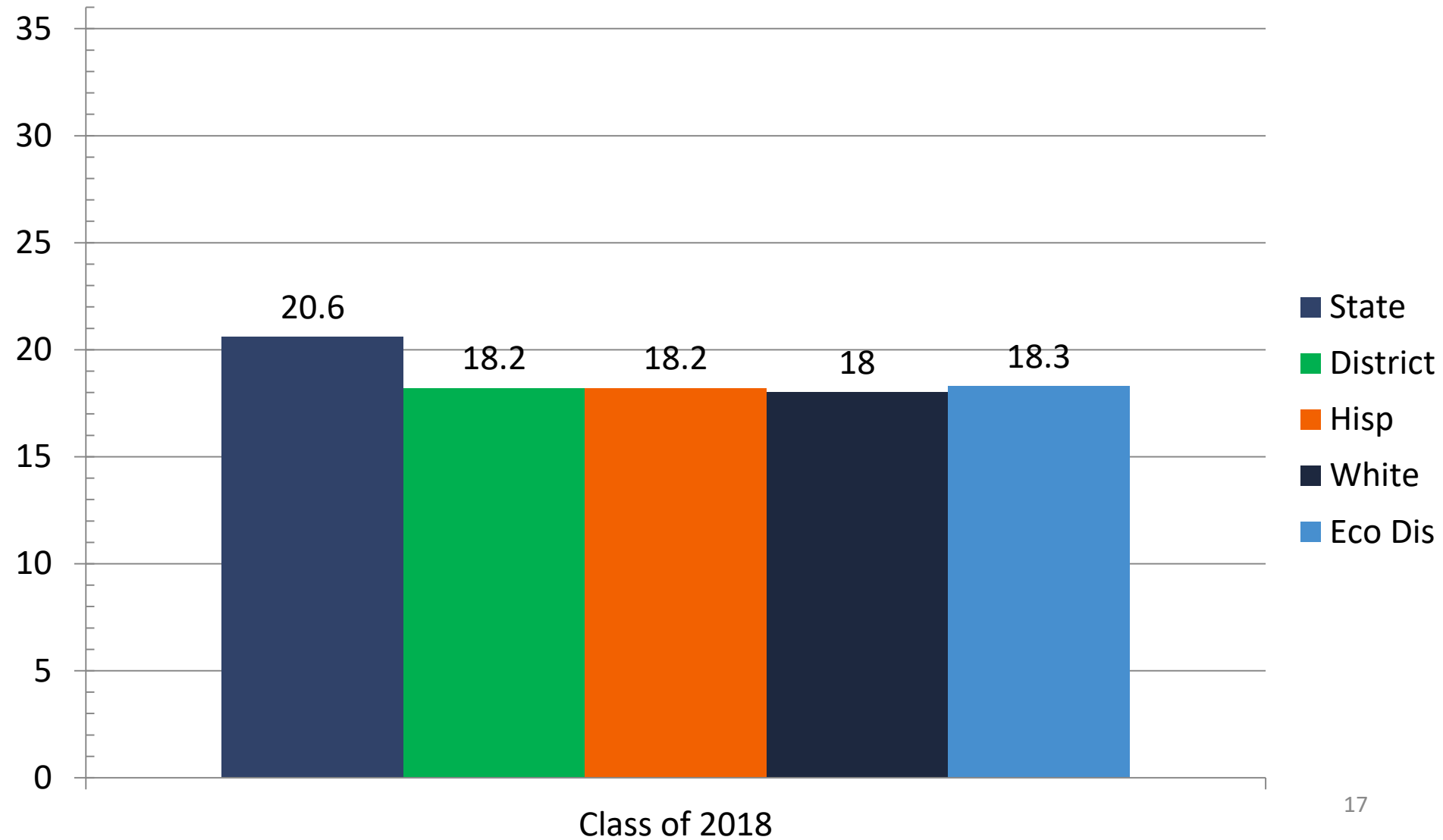

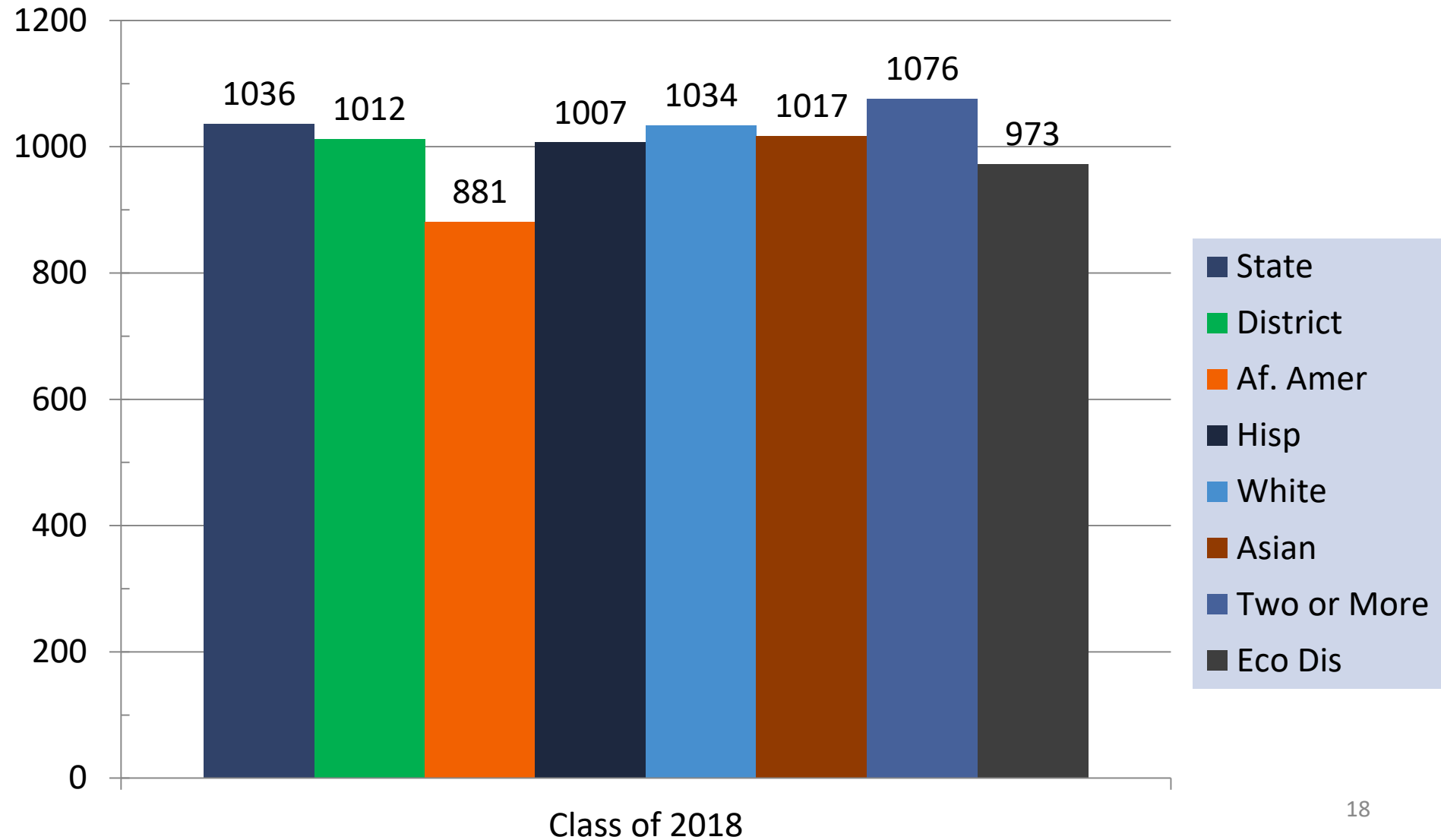

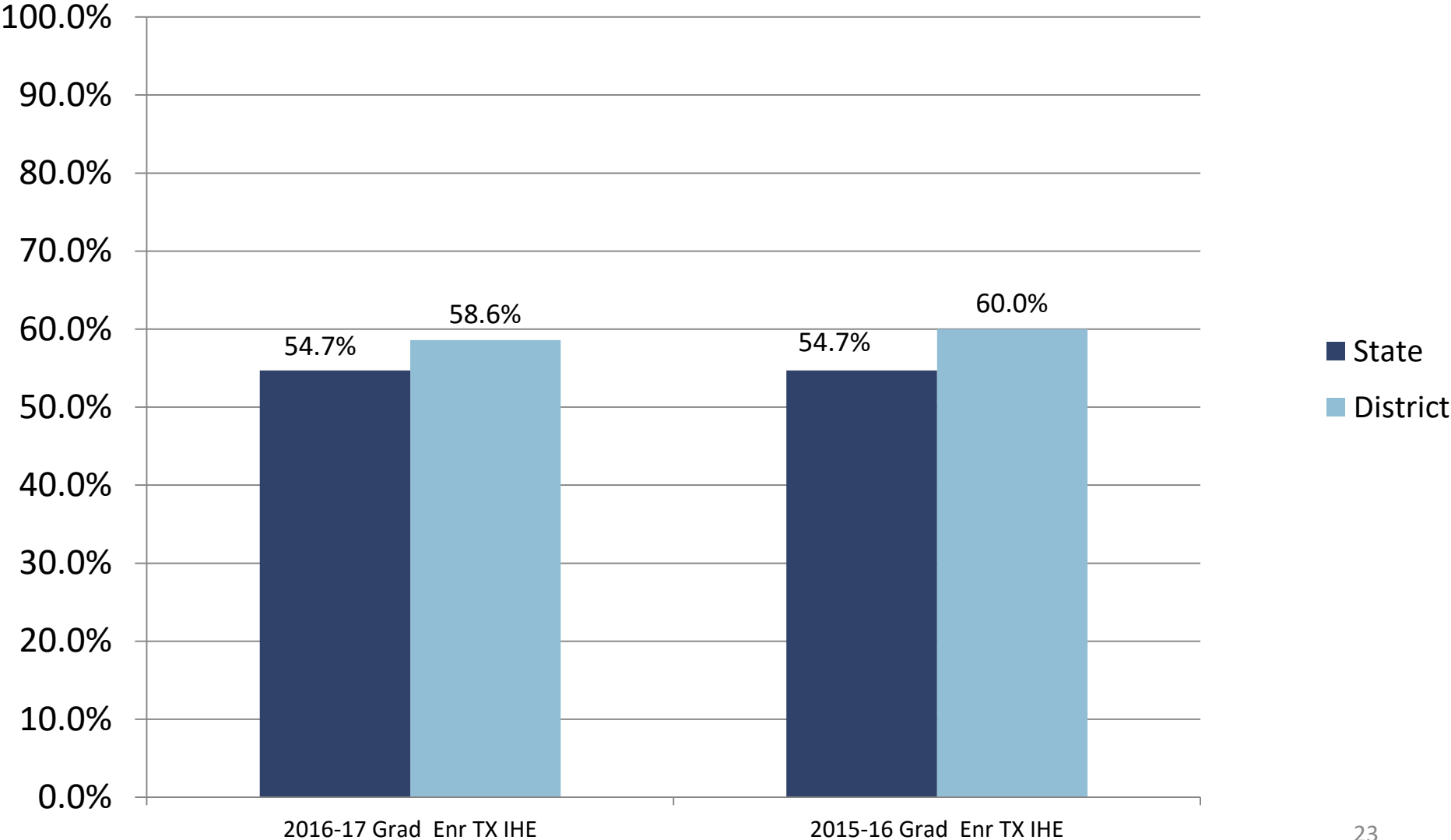
