Lost & Found	<p>Lost items should be reported to the office. Students should turn in any "found" items to the office. The lost and found in Cider Mill is located in Kent and Cannondale. Valuable "finds" are kept in the office. Please check out "Lost and Found" from time to time as remnants are donated quarterly to charity.</p>																												
Lockers	<p>Students will have an individual locker to be used primarily to store outer clothing and backpacks. Lunches generally are kept in lunch buckets near the classroom. Since students do not use locks on their lockers at Cider Mill, if necessary, the teacher can hold any valuables related to school projects. Only magnetic decorations may be used in lockers. No stickers or items requiring tape, peel and stick backs are to be used in or on any lockers.</p>

Birthdays & Celebrations	<p>Children's birthdays are celebrated in various ways in our classrooms. At the start of the school year, your child's teacher will let the parents know how he/she would like to celebrate the birthdays in the classroom. Some teachers have parents read a special book while others may have parents to do a craft with the class. Our school policy allows for healthy treats to be brought into school to be shared with classmates for birthdays and other special whole-class celebrations. For each celebration, individual children may bring in a special treat selected or prepared by their own parent to enjoy.</p>																												
Drop Off & Pick Up	<p>There are two drop off/pick up lines. As you pull into the driveway, North is to the right of the school and South is to the left of the school. Drop off runs from 7:20 am to 7:40 am. After 7:40 am parents or caregivers must park and sign their child in at the Main Office. Doors are locked promptly so teachers can start instruction. In the afternoon, children are dismissed to the pick-up areas at 2:10pm. During pick-up time, please remain in your car and remain in line at all times.</p>																												



Lunch	Students may bring their lunch from home or purchase it at school. Hot and cold lunches cost \$2.75. Monthly menus from Chartwells, our food services provider, are located on our website at https://www.wiltonps.org/departments/chartwells-food-service . Funds may be deposited into your child's account on www.myschoolbucks.com or parents can send a check made out to "Chartwells" to school with their child. School Store	The school store will be open for students 1 day a week during lunch. Students may bring up to \$5.00 to buy items AFTER they eat their lunch. Some items that are available at the school store are pencils, erasers, strings books.																		
School Dismissal Manager	Before the start of school, parents will receive an email from School Dismissal Manager with their activation codes to set up an account. Children's dismissal plans MUST BE ENTERED BY 12:30 P.M. on a regular day and 10:30 A.M. on an early dismissal day for each day. Children will be sent home based on the <i>default plan</i> entered into SDM if a different plan is not entered. Pick up notes should be sent to the teacher if the child is being picked up prior to 2:10 P.M., as teachers do not see their School Dismissal reports until the end of the day. Smart Devices	iPods, cell phones, Smart Watches, electronic games, are not appropriate to have in class and if brought to school should be stored in lockers. "Kindles" (and other e-book readers) can be brought in class with the teacher receiving parental permission. Please note the school is not responsible for lost or stolen devices.																		
Visitors	Parents, relatives, and friends are always welcome to visit our school. Visitors must always enter the school through the main entrance and register at the school office before going to the classroom. Visitors are required to wear a Visitor Name tag when at school for your child's safety. Visitors must sign out as they leave. ALL VISITORS MUST PRESENT LICENSE OR PASSPORT TO REGISTER INTO THE COMPUTER SYSTEM.
