Honors, Dual Enrollment, and AP Course Application

For your application to be considered, the completed packet is due no later than **3pm on February 7th**, **2020** to the school counseling office. All applications must be written in the student's own handwriting; typed applications will not be accepted. It is important to note that the application has been designed with the intent to gather all necessary information for course placement. All decisions from the Honors committee will be considered final, so thorough review and effort is important as you complete the application.

HONORS/DUAL ENROLLMENT/AP COURSE PLACEMENT

All students, even those students currently in advanced classes, must complete the Honors/DE/AP application for any courses they desire to take for the upcoming academic year. Applications can be picked up in the school counseling office or printed from the BCS school website. The application process is designed to provide a holistic approach in assessing student placement.

Applications are due to the school counseling office no later than Friday, February 7th, 2020 by 3:00pm.

Students are required to stay in any Honors, Dual Enrollment (DE), or Advanced Placement (AP) course for the entire year unless the first semester average is a D or lower or there is a recommendation for change by the teacher <u>and</u> the Department Chair.

NOTIFICATION OF COURSE PLACEMENT

Students and parents will receive a notification email by <u>**Tuesday, February 18th, 2020**</u>, prior to course registration, stating which Honors/DE/AP courses the student has been approved to take. If an email is not received, the student has not been approved to enroll in the requested Honors/DE/AP course. Please note the following:

- All placements and subsequent scheduling of those courses will be based on the student's <u>continued</u> <u>acceptable</u> level of performance for the remainder of this academic year.
- All placements <u>can and will</u> be changed if a student's performance proves to be contrary to the supporting information stated in the student's application for advanced classes.

HONORS MAJOR DIPLOMA

- Four full year (1 credit) AP classes are required -- choose from the following:

 - History US History 11
 - Science Biology, Physics 1, Physics C, OR Chemistry
 - Math Calculus OR Statistics
 - World Language Spanish, French, OR Chinese
- Two years of the same World Language
- Completing the outlined 26 credit graduation requirements for Honors Major Diploma
