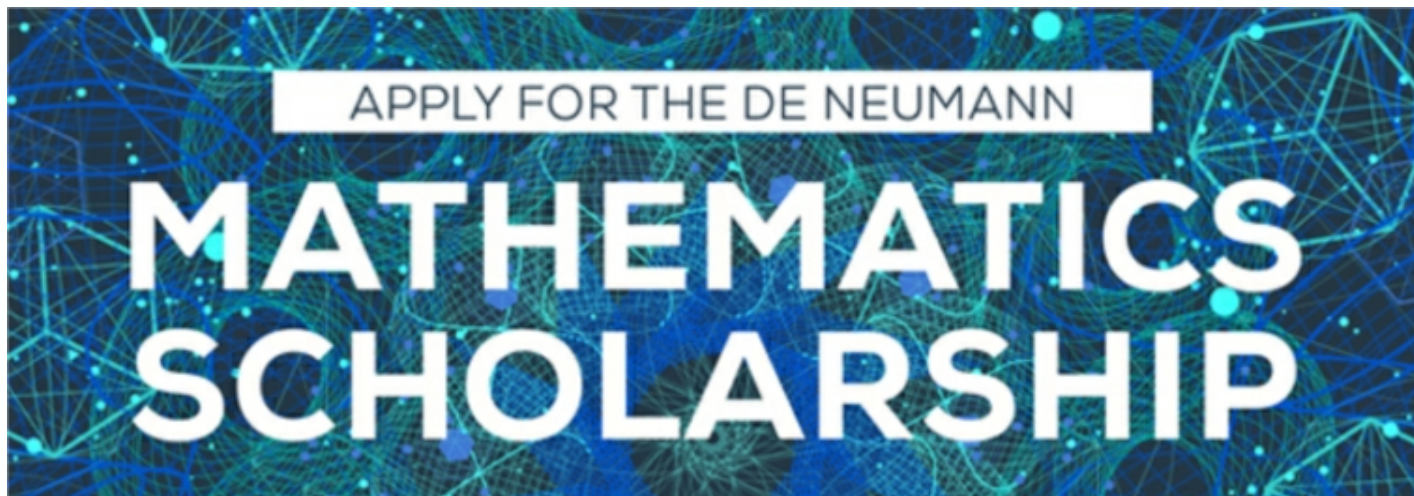




## Termly Bulletin from the RHS Alumni and Development Office Spring 2020



### SCHOOL LAUNCHES DE NEUMANN SCHOLARSHIP

Mathematics has always been fundamental to the School's mission of 'improving navigation'. From September 2020, RHS will offer a Suffolk or Essex-based sixth formers with a real passion for mathematics, a means tested and 100% funded place at the school thanks to Bernard de Neumann (1943 - 2018). This incredibly generous endowment is a major contribution to the School's Centennial Fund, our effort to change 100 lives by our Holbrook Centenary in 2033.

Bernard de Neumann (Nelson 1961) was at the forefront of pioneering mathematical and navigational development, working alongside the likes of Essex University, City University, Rio Tinto, Marconi, and NATO. Thanks to him, the world was able to receive imagery from the American Viking space probe programme including the first colour pictures sent from the surface of Mars. RHS Headmaster, Simon Lockyer, commented: "Professor de Neumann attributed his success to the Lloyds Patriotic Fund supported education he received at RHS. His desire was to leave a legacy to the school to support gifted young mathematicians, giving them the same life-changing opportunity".

RHS is now looking for Year 11 GCSE students from across the region who are planning to study mathematics and/or further mathematics at A Level. The De Neumann Mathematics Scholarship will be offered every other year.

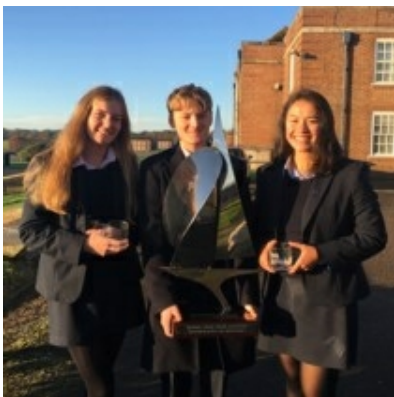
