1. Bright Bytes

- a. Do we want to renew?
 - i. Our data seems consistent over the last couple years
 - ii. Elementary and Middle School struggle with the survey. It is not written to the student's level. Most students are clicking through. The data may not be as accurate as we would like. It is very disruptive to student's schedule.
 - iii. Data is not being utilized

We will not renew our Bright Bytes contract.

2. One to One (Current Ideas)

- a. Device Information/Grade Levels (Cost estimate/deployment strategy)
 - i. 6-12 Laptops – 4 year rotation
 1. After 8th grade rotated to 4-5
 2. After 12th grade buy out option
 - ii. 4-5 Laptops in the classroom
 - iii. K-3 looking into iPads that stay in the classroom
 - iv. 250,000 dollars a year
- b. Deployment
 - i. Fall 2020 Staff Devices
 - ii. Fall 2021 6-12, K-5 as devices become available
 - iii. Fall 2022 All students have access to devices during the school day.
- c. Professional Development and Support.
 - i. Requesting additional technology support position
 - ii. Student help (Student Assistant earn credit)
 - iii. Stipend Position for technology coaches
