Closed system is safer and less susceptible to errors (best for kids)  
Model materials & support material are the same in the lower end models but are separate in more advanced machines.  
Most errors occur in the first five minutes  
Require a fair bit of maintenance. Calibrate machine, fans, and belts  
Google- Free STL to find free preprogrammed items for printing. (thingiverse)  
Software for programming is also free.  
Zortrax.com→ software→ z-suite is the programming software  
Matter hackers gives an educational discount of 5% for machines and materials  
Finest resolution is 0.09mm represents the thickness of the layers that print  
1.75 ABS is the standard construction materials (Ensure the machine takes a generic filament)
