OLD MEETS NEW

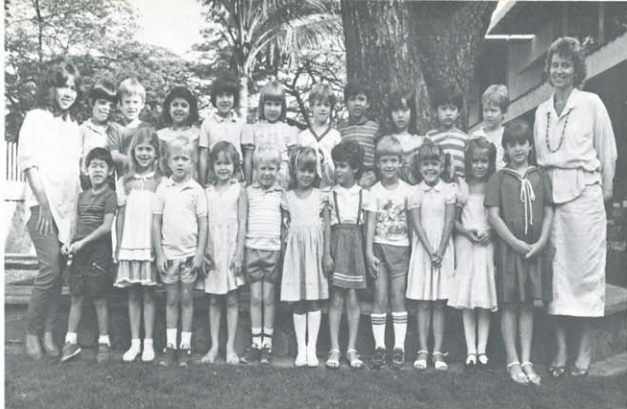
We all watched with great interest as our old school disappeared wall by wall, brick by brick. A beautiful new school replaced our old school under the branches of our favorite tree.

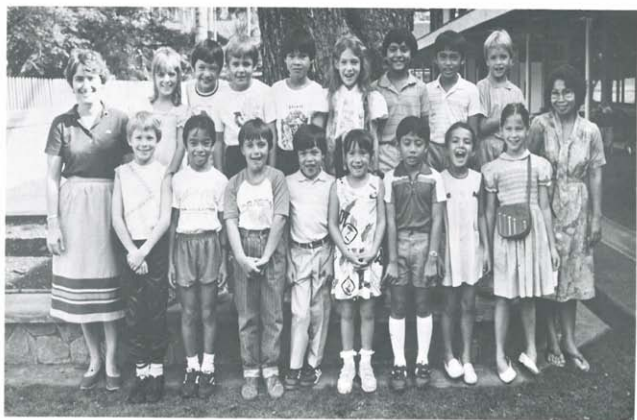
COMPUTERS

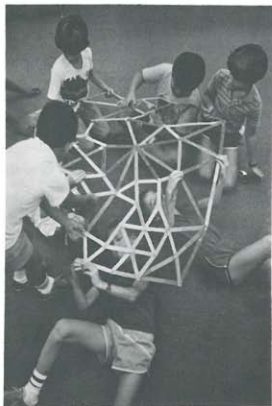


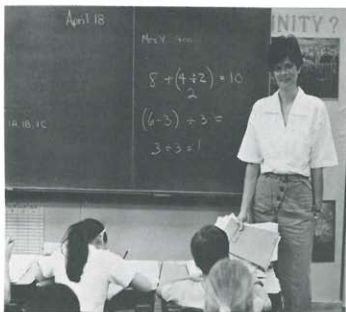
Spring Fair
