For days he made wishes but at times he missed being poor. So one day he wished his last. He started to save his money to buy things for the baby he and Hilda were having and they lived happily on.

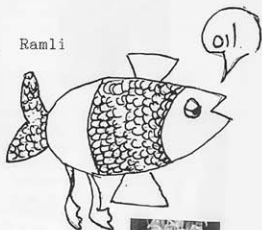

Allan put on a guilty smile and said, "No, I'm not."

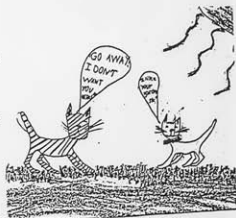

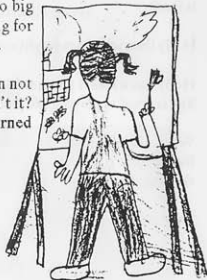
BIOGRAPHY OF BEATRIX POTTER

He got married, had some children and lived happily ever after.



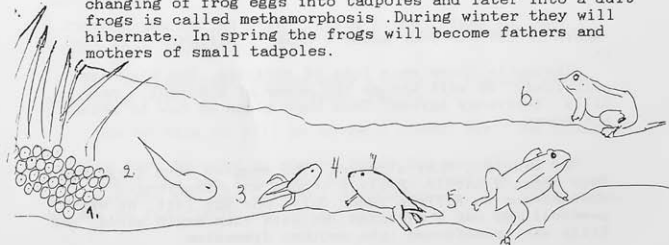
F R O G S

Mikhail Gorbachev is the new leader of the largest nation in the world, the Soviet Union. The Soviet Union is huge, more than twice as big as the United States, and it is the second strongest industrial country in the world.

Mikhail Gorbachev was born on March 2, 1931, in the village of Privolnoye near Stavropol in the northern Caucasus. His parents were peasants, and they were very poor. After the World War II, Mikhail spent school vacations laboring in the wheat fields.

As a young man, he worked as an organizer with the Communist Youth League, the Komsomol. This was of importance to his future.

In the USSR, there is only one party, the Communist Party of the Soviet Union. Anyone who rises to high political office must be a member. It was through the Komsomol that Gorbachev got his political start.

When he was nineteen, he was accepted at the law school of Moscow State University. After he graduated, he went back to Stavropol. He became an official of the city Komsomol.

At the age of 47, he became secretary for state agriculture, in the Central Committee of the Communist Party. This was a very important position. Because of Gorbachev's new job, the family moved to Moscow.

Gorbachev was good at his job, and by 1980 he was a very important man in Soviet politics. Today he is the youngest person ever to lead the Soviet state.

Gorbachev is very active and health conscious, he takes long walks, doesn't smoke, and drinks only moderately. He has wife, Raisa and a daughter, Irina and a granddaughter Oksana.
