





CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT (CE) VS. ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP)

	AP	CE
COST	\$94 per AP test	\$30 one-time application fee + \$15-20 per credit
PASS RATE	Need to pass AP test with 3 or better to earn college credit (depends on university)	Need a C or better to earn college credit
RISK	If student fails, the class is NOT recorded on college transcript	If student fails, the class & grades ARE on college transcript
FOCUS	Help students get a head start in college by rigorous classroom experience	Help students get a head start by earning college credit and learn college processes



NEW CLASSES @ WXHS NEXT YEAR!

Social Dance	FA or PE	Sem.	Learn social dances such as line dances, waltz, fox trot, country swing, and some cultural/folk dances from other societies
CE Adult Roles	FL & CTE	Yr.	0.5 Financial Literature & 0.5 CTE credit. College credit through Weber State University
Exploring Computer Science	Digital Studies or CTE	Sem.	Learn basic concepts of computer science
CE US Government	US Gov.	Sem.	Fulfills US Government requirement. College credit through Weber State University



MORE NEW CLASSES @ WXHS NEXT YEAR!

CE Dance	FA or PE	Sem.	This course provides experience in modern dance technique and the development of such things as physical strength, flexibility, endurance and coordination. Expand dance vocabulary and skills, and develop their creative abilities through improvisation, choreography and performance. CE credit through WSU.
CE Human Development	CTE	Sem.	A study of the development of the individual from conception through adulthood. The focus is on biological, social, emotional, and intellectual aspects across the lifespan, and individual application is emphasized. CE credit through WSU.
