
 Vision invites the students into a college environment where the levels of responsibility and personal investment are higher than are typically the case in a high school setting




Student 2

What does Prep Campus Ministry ask of our students when they return?

Get involved

- CM Student Leadership Team (Monday afternoons)
- Retreats (participate and then lead when eligible)
- Liturgical Ministers (serve at our liturgies)
- Service (including immersion trips)

Travel Costs

We will once again travel by Coach Bus. We leave at night on June 14 and return early morning on June 20. Bus allows us to take a larger group of students and we get door to door service. Final cost will be determined by the number of students attending; the more students we have the cheaper the bus will be. Last year it was \$445 a student.

If interested:

Fill out <u>online group application</u>. There are no paper applications accepted. You will pay the deposit online at the time of registration.

The conference will cost \$425 after you apply group and early app discounts (early app deadline is March 28; \$325 plus \$100 deposit). Final transportation costs will be determined later. Total cost will be approximately \$850 (conference plus transportation).

In addition to submitting online application, students should also submit to Mr. Gualtiere a brief reflection response to the following questions: Why do I want to go to ND Vision? What am I hoping to gain from this experience? (max one page in length typed)

Please apply by February 28, 2020. We will max out at 30 students.

- Financial aid/scholarships for this trip are available through Vision for the conference fees (<u>Emerging Leaders Scholarship</u>)
- Fairfield Prep can assist with transportation costs once they are determined (Fill out financial assistance form). Up to half of the transportation costs can be covered by assistance if a student qualifies; and this is also based on the number of students applying for aid.
