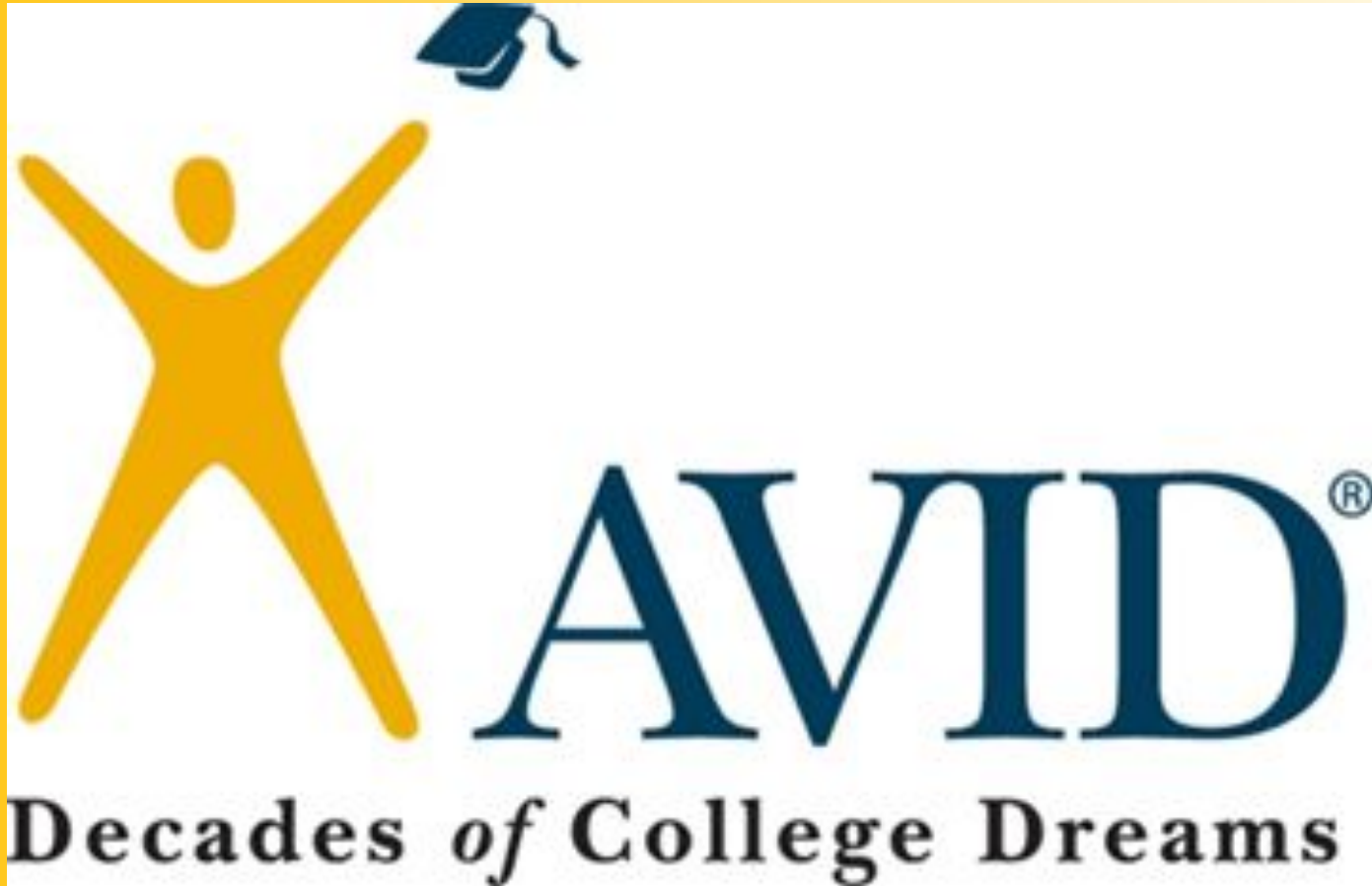

 - Our goal is that every AVID student has the tools to be successful after graduation.

Our Data

- 2018 & 2019 AVID Graduates:
 - 41 Students
 - 24 Student took the SAT
 - 18 Students took the ACT
 - 27 Students applied to a 4 – year university
 - Of the 27 students who applied to a 4 – year university, 100% were accepted to at least one of the universities on their list.

Our Data

- 2019 AVID Graduates:
 - 18 Students
 - 13 Students accepted to a 4 – year university
 - 12 Accepted to California schools
 - 4 Accepted to Private universities
 - 4 Accepted to out-of-state universities
