The South Garland Early College High School, in partnership with Eastfield College, has a primary focus of affording students from underrepresented backgrounds the opportunity to enroll. ECHS combines high school and college in a rigorous, supportive environment that enables struggling students to graduate with college credit and the tools for postsecondary success.

Students will complete a rigorous four-year plan that results in an Associate's Degree from Eastfield Community College. This allows students to think about how they learn and in turn, teachers are able to create targeted plans for success that will close achievement gaps in underrepresented groups. The goal is to make college possible for young adults who otherwise have few opportunities to continue with higher education. We want to serve the underprivileged students, first-generation college goers, English language learners, or any other student that is underrepresented in higher education.
