Swimming Lessons

Swimming this year will be taught to Key Stage Two children only. Each class will swim for a block of one whole term on a Monday afternoon. There are a number of reasons for this. Firstly, each class will get more lessons in one block, enabling them to make more progress; swimming in Key Stage One has in the past been challenging for a number of children. Lessons will be on a Monday afternoon, which means that the children will not be missing core subjects when they swim. We decided, on balance, that this option was best for the majority of children. Holyrood Class will be swimming in the Autumn Term; Windsor in the Spring Term and Buckingham in the Summer Term.

Snacks and Drinks



Healthy ones only please!

Children should only bring healthy snacks into school please. Infant classes (Reception, Year One and Year Two) are provided with free fruit for break times, so additional snacks should not be needed. Junior classes can bring a healthy snack into school, but please no crisps and definitely no sweets or chocolate. We encourage children to bring water bottles into school to be filled with water. However, please do not fill these with juice or squash, as continued sipping of sugary drinks (even those with artificial sweeteners or labelled 'sugar-free') rots teeth.

Also, please can we remind you that we are a nut-free school. We have some children with a nut-allergy and we need to safeguard them against health risks associated with nuts.

Hair Accessories



Please can we ask that modest hair accessories are worn by the children to tie their hair back. Red, white, brown or black ribbons, plain alic bands, bobbles and plain hair slides are acceptable. Also, please can children not wear nail varnish to school. Thank you.

48-Hour Rule!



If your child has sickness or diarrhea, they must stay away from school for 48 hours from the time they were last sick or had diarrhea. This is to safeguard other children so we are going to be strict about this. Also, should your child have flu or a rash appears that could be measles or chicken-pox, then your child should see the GP immediately and stay away from school until they are no longer contagious.
