Six Flags Read To Succeed

Dear Families,

Read to Succeed reading logs were sent home in December. Every student that completes six hours of recreational reading before **February 25, 2020** is eligible for one free admission ticket, valid at the St. Louis Six Flags!

Here's what you need to know:

- * Only K-6th graders are eligible to participate
- * Your child should use the reading log that was sent home to record their reading minutes
- * 6 hours or 360 minutes of reading time must be completed
- * Your child may read books, magazines, comic books (NOTE: homework reading does not count toward reading minutes)
- * When reading minutes/hours are achieved please log the minutes into the link on your reading log.

About the tickets:

- * Tickets will be awarded to students in May
- * Ticket is valid for ONE admission to Six Flags, St. Louis location, on SELECT DATES ONLY during the 2020 season
- * Tickets are NOT FOR RESALE

Tickets **CANNOT** be replaced if lost, stolen, or damaged
