The Board met at 5:00 p.m. to have a Capital Improvement Bond discussion. The Board is moving forward with a bond measure to include the major focus areas, now including a rebuild of the RHS "Old Main" aka "Heritage" building.

**Action Items**

The Consent Agenda was approved, including approval of the Agenda and Minutes of the January 15th Meeting.

The proposed 2020 Budget Calendar was approved as presented by the District's Chief Operations Officer, Cheryl Northam.

Budget Committee members John Markovich, Larissa Hoskin and Bernis Wagner were reappointed to positions on the Budget Committee. Chair Garcia spoke for his fellow Board members in expressing appreciation to these dedicated volunteers for their willingness to continue to serve as committee members.

A Report of Division 22 Standards was presented by Teaching and Learning Director, Michelle Knee, and acknowledged by the School Board as required by ODE prior to February 1, 2020.

A telemedicine Request for Qualifications (RFQ) was rescinded by the Board to allow for a committee to be formed to help define what service model would best serve students attending Roseburg Schools.

Policies approved for Second Reading and Adoption included the following:

- ◆ KI: Public Solicitation in District Facilities;
- ◆ KJ: Commercial Advertising; and
- ◆ KJ-AR: Commercial Advertising.

Existing Policy KI/KJ: Public Solicitation/Advertising in District Facilities, was then rescinded by the Board as it has been replaced by separate new policies KI and KJ.

Revised Policy AC and the accompanying AR were both approved for First Reading:

- ◆ AC: Nondiscrimination; and
- ◆ AC-AR: Discrimination Complaint Procedure.

**Student Leadership Report**

RHS students Marin Gray, Isabelle Hervey, Chelsea Miller, and Alema Norris all shared current activities at the high school. Students made it through Finals Week and are settling into the new semester and schedules. Key Club, Interact and NHS clubs partnered to establish the new Community Closet to benefit students in need that will be staffed by parents each Wednesday after school. RHS was recognized as a National Champion School through Unified Partners Sports for meeting standards of excellence in inclusivity. A presentation will be made during half-time at the Boys' Basketball game this Friday. On Feb. 6th, the Band Bingo Night takes place in the Student Center. FBLA regionals will be hosted at RHS this Saturday. "Curious Savage" performances will be shown in late February. Students are preparing for Mental Health Week and the upcoming Arts Assembly. Alema reported all the latest sports results, and noted that district and state competitions are coming up soon with the seasons wrapping up at the end of February. A book study of "Legacy vs. Likes" is being undertaken by students to help build skills and leadership understanding.
