

Children move up naturally to the Prep School at 7 years of age, and the new school day is full and active, both inside and outside the classroom, with Food Technology in our superb facility, now a part of the timetabled curriculum.

Subject specialists teach all children from Year 5 onwards, making the most of their in-depth knowledge and wealth of experience in their individual subject areas.



Art, Ceramics and Design Technology are especially strong. Pupils produce work in a variety of media exploring the use of texture and colour. In this way they learn the skills and techniques necessary to enhance and develop their natural creative abilities, which are proudly displayed throughout the school.

At Yateley Manor we offer your child the opportunity to experience life beyond the school grounds, be it a fieldwork trip to explore the Isle of Purbeck, a visit to discover the mechanics of our Parliament in Whitehall, a residential trip to Normandy where Year 7 pupils are immersed in a foreign language, inspirational trips to London galleries and museums, or a sports tour to South Africa.
