Additional Information

Hair

Hair styles should not inhibit learning and should therefore not cover the eyes. Long hair should be away from the face and must be tied back with red, grey, black or white hair accessories. Extreme hairstyles (shorter than Grade 4), including “steps”, spikey haircuts, highlights, colouring or bleaching are not acceptable in school. No gel or other hair products should be worn.

Jewellery

The wearing of jewellery, including pierced earrings, is not permitted.

School Shop

Opening Hours:

Tuesdays and Wednesdays 3:00pm - 5:30pm. Term time only.

Appointments:

New pupils are kitted out by appointment.

An appointment can take between 40 and 60 minutes per pupil. Due to limited space in the shop we can only accommodate a maximum of two accompanying adults per child.
