Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2018-2019 educational progress for **Novi Middle School**. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. If you have any questions about the AER, please contact Robert Baker, Principal of Novi Middle School, for assistance.

For the 2018-19 school year, schools were identified using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% as the state. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or has a graduation rate at or below 67%. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Novi Middle School has not been given one of these labels.

In April, 2018 the Michigan Department of Education released a new, *Parent Dashboard for School Transparency*. The dashboard is meant to be a "living" tool to show parents accurate and objective data about all schools in the state. You can view our school's Dashboard at: shorturl.at/beiHJ

As a building, Novi Middle School achieves at a high level. However, data in the AER indicates a number of achievement gaps that need to be addressed. Data in the AER indicates some gaps in the areas of reading, writing and math. These gaps exist between the general population and following sub groups: African American, Economically Disadvantaged, English Language Learners and Students with Disabilities. In order to address these gaps in achievement, our building is implementing a number of initiatives. One example is that we have hired a full time math interventionist and a full time English Interventionist. These positions allow for the identification of students who demonstrate academic needs in these skill areas and then the provision for targeted push-in classroom support to provide additional guidance and academic support for these learners.

Process for Assigning Pupils to the School

The Novi Community School District has one middle school. Students in the Novi Community School District boundaries attend 7th and 8th grades at Novi Middle School.

School Description and Student Enrollment

In the 2018-19 school year, Novi Middle School had 1047 students. Approximately 45% of those students are Asian or Asian American. About 40% are White, 3% are Hispanic, 8% are African American, and 4% are two or more races. There

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are at least 25 home languages spoken by our students and about 13% of our students are English Learners. About 6% of the students at Novi Middle School are considered economically disadvantaged and are enrolled in free or reduced lunch programs. Approximately 46 students at NMS are students with active special education individualized education plans.

Upon registration, a resident must show proof of residency within the boundaries of the Novi Community School District. All seventh and eighth grade students in the Novi Community School District attend Novi Middle School. Throughout their two years at NMS, students develop new areas of interest through a variety of exploratory and elective classes including world languages (Spanish, French, Japanese, German), art, computers, life skills, vocal music and instrumental music (orchestra, band). NMS offers a wide range of clubs, sports, intramural and extracurricular activities.

Core Curriculum

In 2018-2019, the NCS D will continue to refine its core curriculum maps, courses and units of study in the four core content areas (Math, English Language Arts, Science and Social Studies). This information can be viewed at the NCS D website shorturl.at/CKTW1 and by clicking on the appropriate grade levels and content areas. With the implementation of Common Core State Standards (CCSS), the district has aligned its curriculum with grade level expectations and CCSS and structured common assessments which are aligned with state and national standards. The use of the Atlas Rubicon Curriculum Maps system provides a common structure and easily accessible warehouse for intended curriculum as well as actual curriculum presented.

Nationally Normed Achievement Assessment Data

Each fall and spring, Novi students in grades K-10 take the nationally-normed Northwest Evaluation Association (NWEA) Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) tests in Reading and Math. NWEA tests are unique in that they adapt to be appropriate for the student's level of learning. As a result, each student has the same opportunity to succeed and maintain a positive attitude toward testing. The Novi Middle School staff uses the results to improve our curriculum, instruction, and assessment procedures and to help all students be successful. Novi Middle School students consistently achieve higher than the national average. In the 2018-19 school year, eighth grade students also completed the PSAT 8 assessment of English and math skills for the first time.

Local Assessments

At NMS we use a variety of qualitative and quantitative methods (NWEA, M-STEP, local standardized assessments) to assess the whole child. Students are assessed both formally and informally in all classes using a variety of instruments including projects, performances and technology based presentations. Common assessments in mathematics, language arts, science and social studies were developed by NMS teachers and are administered to all students.
