Registration is open for the opportunity to participate in free World Language Competency testing here in Northshore this school year. This is an opportunity for students who can read, write, listen and speak a language other than English to earn up to four competency credits and/or the Seal of Biliteracy designation on their high school transcript. More detailed information about the test and earning credits can be found on the World Language Competency Test website. Here is the pertinent information regarding the upcoming testing opportunity:

- The test on Feb. 29 is open to grades 7 through 12
- Date/Time: Saturday, Feb. 29, 9:00 a.m. 3:00 p.m. (check-in @ 8:30, testing begins @ 9:00)
- Location: Inglemoor High School
- Registration (online): Opens on Friday, Jan. 10 @ 8:00 a.m. and closes on Wednesday, Feb, 5 @ 4:00 p.m. or when we reach our max capacity of 130 registrations
- If spaces for this testing period are filled, we will be in touch to provide an additional testing date in the spring.
