2020 Spring League Registration



St. Joe's Pony Baseball offers instructional and competitive baseball for boys and girls ages 4 to 14. We promote the development of strong character, a sense of responsibility and good sportsmanship in our players. We are affiliated with PONY Baseball and have been providing youth baseball to families in the Joliet area for 80 years.

Shetland Division (4, 5 & 6 year olds)

- Focuses on instruction for beginning players, including transition from hitting from a tee to balls pitched by a coach.
- Fee: \$90 if registered by 4/3/2020*

Pinto Division (7 & 8 year olds)

- Players continue to learn baseball fundamentals while they begin pitching to each other.
- Fee: \$125 if registered by 3/15/2020*

Mustang Division (9 & 10 year olds)

- Begins the player's training in the complete game of baseball.
- Live pitching, stealing and most regular rules of baseball. This next level of baseball play brings a lot of excitement!
- Fee: \$145 if registered by 3/15/2020*

Bronco Division (11 & 12 year olds)

- Bronco teams will play against teams from a conference of other local baseball organizations.
- Games played using full baseball rules to begin preparing players for high school baseball.
- Fee: \$165 if registered by 2/15/2020*

Pony Division (13 & 14 year olds)

- Pony teams will play against teams from a conference of other local baseball organizations (between 20-30 games).
- Increased focus on player development in preparation for high school baseball.
- Fee: \$175 if registered by 2/15/2020*

*\$25 late fee following registration deadline

Registration

- Online registration is now open

Fees

- Each family will be charged a \$100 family fee, which is eligible to be refunded after having participated in one of several volunteer opportunities (manager, coach, team mom, concession stand, picnic volunteer, etc.).
- Each family is also responsible for the sale of raffle tickets as part of St. Joe's annual fundraiser. Families with a single player will be asked to sell \$100 worth of tickets, while families of 2 or more players will be asked to sell \$150 in raffle tickets.

Team Selection

- Team managers will contact players following player selection.

Practices:

- Practices will be held 2-3 times per week starting in mid-March for Pinto through Pony.
- Shetland practices will begin in mid-April.
- Practice times and locations are determined by the team manager.

Games

- Games begin in April for Pinto through Pony. Once games begin, you should expect 2 games and 1 practice per week.
- Games begin in early May for Shetland division.
- Each team will play 15-18 games.
- Pinto through Pony divisions will also compete in a division tournament at the end of the season, due to be completed by end of the third week in June.
