CORE CLASSES

- Everyone takes:
 - Math
 - English
 - U.S. History
 - Science
 - P.E.
 - Health
 - Digital Literacy



MATH

- Every Math 7 or Math 7 Honors student will register for Math 8.
- In Math 8 students will learn through differentiated instruction and blended learning with online programs such as Mathia and Aleks. Honors opportunities will be given to all students in this course and students will receive the Honors designation on their transcript if they choose to complete the honors opportunities offered throughout each term.
- Accelerated Math students will register for Secondary Math I Honors.

Math Progression for 8th grade:

- Math 7 → Math 8
- Math 7 Honors → Math 8 Honors
- Accelerated Math 7/8 → Secondary Math I Hon.



SUMMER MATH OPTIONS

- The USTAR program offers math classes through the district.
- You **MUST** let your counselor know if you will be completing a summer class.

HONORS ENGLISH, HISTORY, AND SCIENCE

- These classes are advanced classes. The reading and writing is more rigorous and the projects are bigger.
- Your reading Lexile level in this class should be 1150.
- Students may sign up for Honors English, Science, or U.S. History.
- If you are interested in taking an honors class, you must:
 1. Sign the honors application.
 2. Circle the class you want on your registration form.
 3. Think about what you love. Take a class in that area.



P.E.

- We enroll ALL 8th graders in P.E. 8 (traditional P.E.) for ONE semester.
- If you want P.E. for a FULL year, you can take any of these classes as an “elective” class:
 1. P.E. 8 (traditional P.E.)
 2. Basketball 8
 3. Fitness 8
 - Yoga
 - Circuit Training
 - Kick Boxing
 - Zumba
 - Weight Lifting



FINE ARTS CREDIT

- All students must take ONE credit (two semester classes) of art or music between 7th and 8th grade.
- This can be:
 - art
 - choir
 - orchestra
 - band
- If you have not taken this in 7th grade, we wrote **ART** on your registration form.



ART

- If you want to take an art class, you must first take Art Foundations 1.
- After you have Art Foundations 1, you can take any of the other art classes. If you took 2-D Art or 3-D Art, you can take it again in 8th or 9th grade. Mrs. Harris will have different projects for you to do.

CHOIR

(COUNTS FOR FINE ARTS CREDIT)

- Girl's Choir (semester or full year)
- Boy's Choir (semester or full year)
- If you want a full year of choir, write it in two boxes on your registration form.



BAND

(COUNTS FOR FINE ARTS CREDIT)

- If you are in Band Level 1 this year, sign up for Band 2 Concert.
- If you are NOT in band, you can take Band Level 1 next year.
- Try outs for Jazz band are in May. If you make Jazz band, we put it into your schedule for a 0 period before school.
 - You do not write Jazz band on your registration form.



ORCHESTRA

(COUNTS FOR FINE ARTS CREDIT)

- If you are currently in Orchestra 1, Mrs. Krivanec wants you to take Orchestra 2. You need to have a full year commitment to this class.
- Orchestra 1 is available to all students wishing to participate in orchestra, who do not have previous experience.



DIGITAL LITERACY

- This is a state required class.
- ALL 8th grade students will be enrolled in the class.
- You learn computer skills for Microsoft Word, PowerPoint, and Excel.



CTE

- If you like College & Career Awareness classes, take a more advanced and in-depth form of them.

Classes are:

- Creative Coding 1
- FCS Exploration (Family & Consumer Science)
- Exploring Tech. 1 (woods/metals)
- Exploring Tech. 2 (engineering/design)



WORLD LANGUAGES

- No state college in Utah requires a world language for entrance. However, the U of U highly encourages students to enter the university with 2 years of a foreign language.
- The Regents' Scholarship requires 2 years of a Foreign Language in 9th - 12th grades.



SPANISH

- The following classes are available:
 - Spanish 1
 - Spanish 2
 - Spanish 3
- If you would like to take another language in high school here are the options:
 - BHS languages offered: Spanish, German, and French
 - WXHS languages offered: Spanish, French, and American Sign Language (ASL)



ALTERNATE CLASSES
