Immunization Requirements

Please make sure your child's immunizations are up to date or that exempt

letters are turned in by February 19, 2020. You should have received notification from the School District Nurse if the record is not up to date. If your child's immunizations are incomplete, they will be unable to attend school after the exclusion date, which is February 19, 2020.

Immunization clinic hours are limited. We encourage families to seek appointments for vaccinations in advance of February. Families can seek immunization at their doctor's office or clinic, the Benton County Health Department, or at a pharmacy for children over the age of seven years old.

Children without health insurance are eligible for free or very low cost vaccines at the Benton County Health Department. To schedule an appointment please call 541-766-6812.


What the research shows....
