

Rowlett High School Prom Dress Code

Dress Code must be adhered to throughout the entire event.

No jeans, torn pants, shorts, or t-shirts. No facial piercings other than nose for males or females.

Students should dress in formal attire:

- Dresses, slacks, dress shirt & nice shoes (jackets and ties/bow ties are encouraged, but not required)
- Pantsuits and dress slacks are also acceptable.

The following will **NOT** be permitted:

- Exposed midriff
- Dresses must not be low-cut in front (mesh must be present and not see through) or extremely low cut in back (opening in back must not fall below the waist).
- Hemlines must fall to below the fingertips with shoulders at rest.
- Skirts/dresses with multiple layers must have a solid layer that comes below the fingertips with shoulders at rest.
- Slits in dresses must not be higher than below the fingertips with shoulders at rest.
- Strapless and spaghetti straps will be permitted.
- Extremely tight clothing and dresses/skirts that ride up to an inappropriate length when walking or dancing are not acceptable.
- No see through attire including low-cut fronts or revealing cut-outs.
- No torn clothing

All Students:

- If you have questions about your dress for the dance, you need to get it approved by an AP in the AP office.
- The determination of the appropriateness of student dress and grooming shall rest with the principal/assistant principals.
- Students and their dates who are non-compliant with the dress code will not be admitted to the dance or will be escorted out of the dance.
- If at any point during the prom a student becomes out of dress code, they will be asked to leave.
- No refunds will be given for dance dress code infractions in which these students are asked to leave.
