Routine Reminders:

10 Minute Rule in the Prep School

Now the darker afternoons are here please help us to ensure your son is safe by reminding him about the 10 minute rule, which is no child should remain on his own or in an area in the car park or another section of the school (i.e. Music School) for longer than 10 minutes.

He should come back to the Prep School where a member of staff is always on duty and will make the appropriate communication.

Boys in Year 3 and 4 must be collected from the Prep school if parents are late, or your son has attended an afterschool activity. Boys are not allowed to walk down to the Girls' school car park unaccompanied.

Boys in Year 5 and 6 do have permission to walk unaccompanied to the Girls' school car park to meet their parent/carer who maybe late to collect or has attended an afterschool activity.

Road Safety

As the afternoons grow darker, please speak with your children about their personal safety:

- Don't use mobiles to talk or text and turn off music while crossing the road
- Give the road your full attention while you're crossing, even with a group of friends
- Look out for your friends' safety too.
- Allow coaches to depart before crossing to give you a clear view of the road.
- Don't take any chances when you're crossing cars may not be able to stop in time.
- Pedestrian crossings aren't just for young children, they keep everybody safe.

If you are parking at the Girls' school please ensure you park up, and get out of the car to meet with your son. Do not allow son to jump into your car whilst you are driving up to meet him, as this is extremely dangerous.

Poor Weather Arrangements

In the event of bad weather, the schools will remain open whenever possible and parents are asked to make every endeavour to get their sons to school each day. Coach drivers are urged to make every effort to reach the schools, trying alternative routes where necessary.

However, if the schools have to close, parents should be aware of the following: A message will be placed on the schools' website as soon as a decision to close is taken. An SMS message will be sent to your mobile phone to alert you.

Please check the website regularly in the event of bad weather. Please try not to telephone the school as we must keep the lines clear for urgent messages from the coach stewards. The default setting unless shown otherwise on the school website is that the school is open.

Kit

We recommend that boys wear a tracksuit, skins and gloves during the winter months. On our return in January as it is the football term, we insist all boys wear shin pads as this is an essential part of their kit. Moulded studs and rugby studs are suitable footwear for the football term.
