

Online Auction Opens February 17, 2020 at Noon

DREVIEW AND BID!

The auction website allows you to 1) bid on Online Auction items, 2) bid on Silent Auction items, and 3) preview Live Auction items.

- The Online Auction begins on Monday, February 17, at noon and closes on Thursday, February 27, at 10 pm. Winners will be notified by email and/or text message immediately following the close of the Online Auction.
- The Silent Auction begins online on Monday, February 17, at noon. Bidding will continue until the start of the Live Auction, except for items that are purchased through the "Buy It Now" option.
- The Live Auction online preview begins on Monday, February 17. The preview provides the opportunity to see all of the items that will be available for bidding at the Live Auction on February 29. If you would like to place an absentee bid for a Live Auction item, email Christine Sharkey at csharkey@potomacschool. org by Thursday, February 27, at noon.

Auction Website Instructions

- If you would like to preview the items included in this year's auction, log on to Potomac's 2020 auction website: potomacs2020.ggo.bid.
- Click on the link on the main page for a preview. This page will become the Online Auction bidding site when the Online Auction and Silent Auction open on Monday, February 17, at noon.
- Potomac parents, grandparents, and friends will receive an email when the Online Auction opens. This email will include instructions on how to bid, as well as a registration link. Once you click the registration link in the email, you will be able to log in with your account information from last year. If you are new to the system, you will be provided instructions for creating your account.

- If you do not receive an email when the Online Auction opens, visit potomacs2020.ggo.bid. Once on the Online Auction page, click the green "Start Bidding" button and follow the prompts to either log in with an old account or create a new account.
- Once you have an account, you will be able to bid on items. You can search for items by name or number, using the magnifying glass, or by category under the menu on the left side of the page.
- When placing a bid, you can select the next incremental amount or a larger amount. If you choose to bid more, you can set a maximum bid. If you set a maximum bid, the system automatically will bid in your favor up to your maximum bid, until you are outbid or until the Online Auction or Silent Auction, as applicable, closes. You will receive an email and/or text message alerting you when you have been outbid. To keep track of bidding activity for a particular item, select the star icon. To find packages with zero bids, click the "No Bids" category on the left side of the page. Please note that the Online Auction website is optimized for use on smartphones.







A Private Flight on the Iconic WWII P-51 Mustang **Fighter Aircraft**



Calling all WWII and aviation enthusiasts! Buckle up for the flight of a lifetime... This experience includes a full briefing, walk-around, and one-hour flight in one of the most important aircraft of WWII. Powered by a Rolls Royce 1495-horsepower Merlin engine and based at the Manassas Airport in Virginia, this P-51 is right off the factory floor, identical to how it would have been delivered to the US Army Air Corps in 1943, and maintained and flown by a single owner-operator. With only about 15,000 P-51s built, this aircraft is a true original. Winner will participate in strafing runs over the rural Virginia countryside and their choice of aerobatics, including loops, rolls, split-S, and other approved maneuvers for the P-51.

The Mustang was the first single-engine plane based in Britain to penetrate Germany; first to reach Berlin: first to go with the heavy bombers over the Ploiesti oil fields in Romania; and first to make a major-scale, all-fighter sweep specifically to hunt down the dwindling Luftwaffe. One of the highest honors accorded to the Mustang was its rating in 1944 by the Truman Senate War Investigating Committee as "the most aerodynamically perfect pursuit plane in existence."

The aircraft is owned by Pamela Marie, LLC, and flown by Andrew McKenna. Mr. McKenna maintains his Commercial Instrument and Multi Engine rating along with his Level I surface waiver for formation and solo aerobatics in his P-51 Mustang and North American T-6 Texan. Mr. McKenna has accumulated over 3,000 hours of total time with more than 1,000 hrs in the P-51 and 600+ hours in the T-6, performing at airshows and events up and down the East Coast. He has performed at over 100 aerial events since 2009, including many as a volunteer at Arlington National Cemetery in his P-51 for fallen airmen. McKenna is also a civilian member of the elite Air Force Heritage Flight Foundation, where the active-duty USAF planes fly in formation with the older generation front line fighters at airshows and events around the globe.






