

OUR MISSION

Our Lady of Tepeyac High School is an all-girls, college preparatory, Catholic high school located in the Little Village community. Tepeyac offers young women an opportunity to grow academically, spiritually, and socially. Our students hail from 29 different zip codes across the Chicagoland area. 80% of our students are Latina and 20% of our students are African American. 96% of our students' families fall below the poverty line and 63% of our students speak Spanish at home.

Our Lady of Tepeyac High School is an integral part of the Little Village community. Once home to Eastern European immigrants, Little Village is now considered one of the largest Mexican American communities in the country.

QUICK FACTS


- Tepeyac is the most affordable Catholic high school in Chicago; our tuition is less than \$6,000 a year.
- 96% of students receive a need-based scholarship to attend Tepeyac.
- The average income of our families is \$36,700; our families work so hard to provide the best education for their daughters.
- Tepeyac has small class sizes, which allows our teachers to focus on the social emotional growth of our young women.
- In order to prepare our young women to be competitive in the college application process, Tepeyac students participate in a variety of summer opportunities and internships.

COLLEGE READINESS

- College Readiness program works with each grade level to set goals, participate in internships, apply to colleges and obtain scholarships and financial aid.
- Students visit college campuses each Fall, Spring, and Summer.
- All students attend a college fair each March.
- Freshwoman Seminar launches 9th graders on the path to college.
- Senior College Seminar guides seniors from personal statements through applications, housing, and scholarships.

DRIVEN TO SUCCEED

Despite being faced with poverty, gang violence, the realities of significant household responsibilities, jobs of their own, our young women succeed in high school by engaging in rigorous academics, volunteering in the community, and excelling on the court and the field. 100% of our graduates go to college.



OUR YOUNG WOMEN GROW IN FAITH

Our Lady of Tepeyac High School strives to strengthen and enrich the faith life of all students on campus through participation in experiences of prayer and service in the Catholic tradition. OLT fosters the faith life of our girls in a variety of ways throughout the year:

- Daily prayer and monthly all-school masses,
- Prayer services corresponding to events in the Liturgical year as well as students' lives.
- An annual retreat for each grade level (including the Kairos retreat for Seniors).
- Service requirements that work to reflect the heart of Catholic Social Teaching.
