 - High school will be responsible for cost (\$177 per class)

 - Approximately 30 students will need developmental reading/writing in summer
 - Summer 2: July 6th – August 6th
 - To be eligible for DIRW 0310, students who are writing met must score the following on reading: 342 and up OR 310-341 & ABE of 5 or 6
 - Students not writing met would need to score a 348 or higher
