is a college-preparatory magnet program for students who are interested in pursuing careers in science, technology, engineering or mathematics (STEM). This program provides a rigorous education to prepare students for life in the twenty-first century. Our dedicated instructors and mentors have experience in aerospace technology, robotics and computer-aided design and have worked to align TEAM's rigorous curriculum with university engineering programs. TEAM students graduate prepared to take the next step - enrolling in a university level STEM program - with confidence in the field they have chosen and with the skills that will ensure their success.

### **EARLY COLLEGE HIGH SCHOOL**

Our Early College High School program called Earn a Degree Graduate Early (EDGE) allows participating students to graduate with both a high school diploma and an associate's degree from Tulsa Community College at the end of their high school career. This rigorous, cohort-based program is free to participating students and only offered at two high schools across Tulsa Public Schools.

Tulsans have made a five-year \$414 million investment in safe and accessible schools; state-of-the-art educational technology; sustainable student transportation; and rigorous, engaging, and culturally sustaining learning experiences that prepare students for success in college and careers.

### At Memorial High School, the 2021 Bond for Tulsa Public Schools includes:

- » LaFortune Stadium turf replacement and waterproofing, replacement of the school's tennis court, and pool refresh work.
- » Redesigning the cafeteria into a flexible, comfortable, multi-use space for students, teachers, and support professionals;
- » Upgrades to the auditorium lighting and sound system and new stage curtains;
- » Remodels for the school's science labs and investments in STEM equipment;
- » Security enhancements at the school's main entrance;
- » ADA-accessibility improvements in school restrooms and at building exits;
- » Parking lot resurfacing and improvements to exterior lighting; and
- » Repairing and upgrading the HVAC system federally funded by the CARES Act.
