

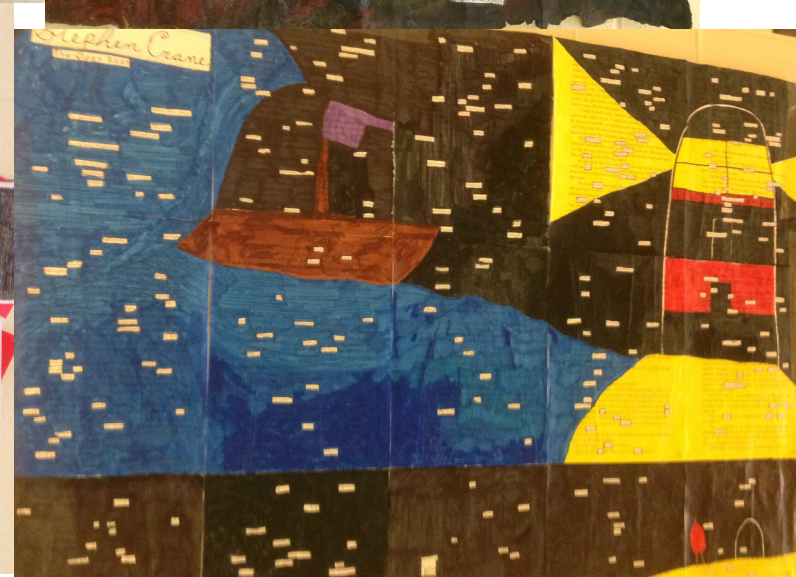
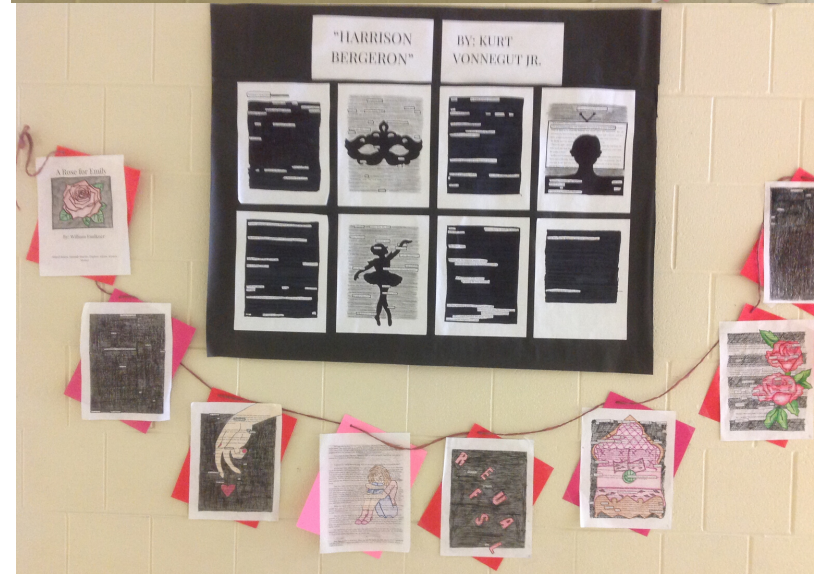
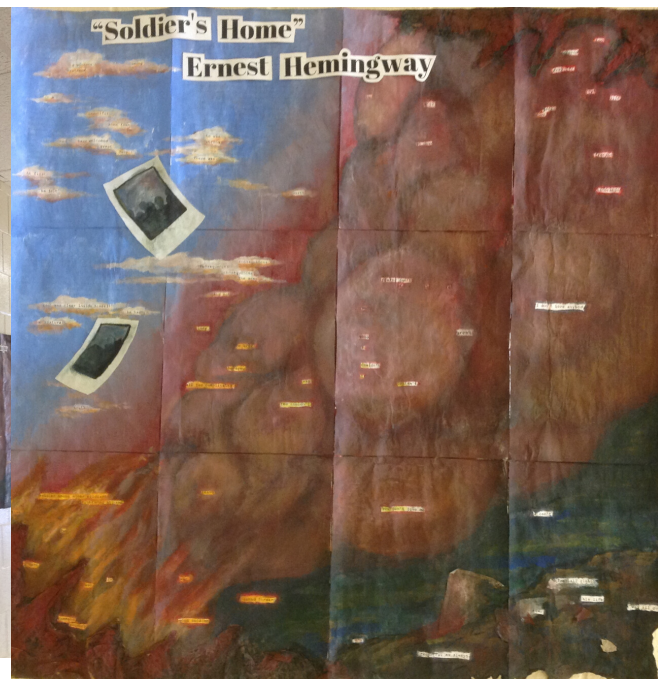

They are the winners of Mrs. Zurcher's 2nd Annual Chili Cook-Off. They won this year's cook-off with their Fiesta White Chicken Chili.



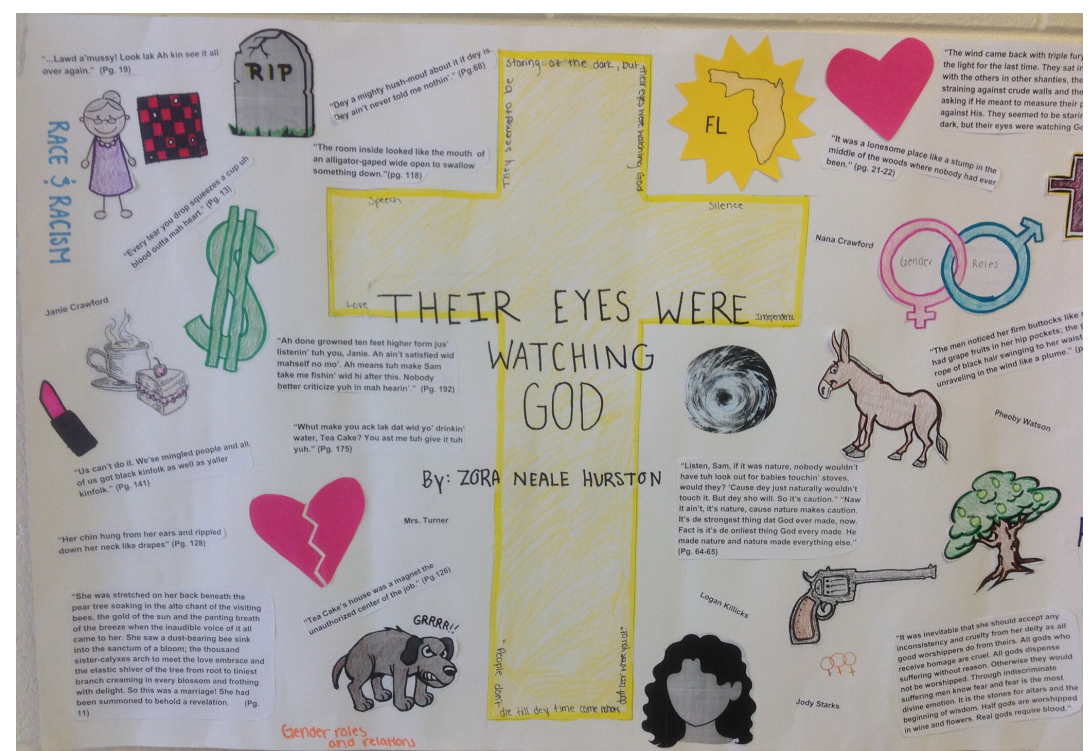
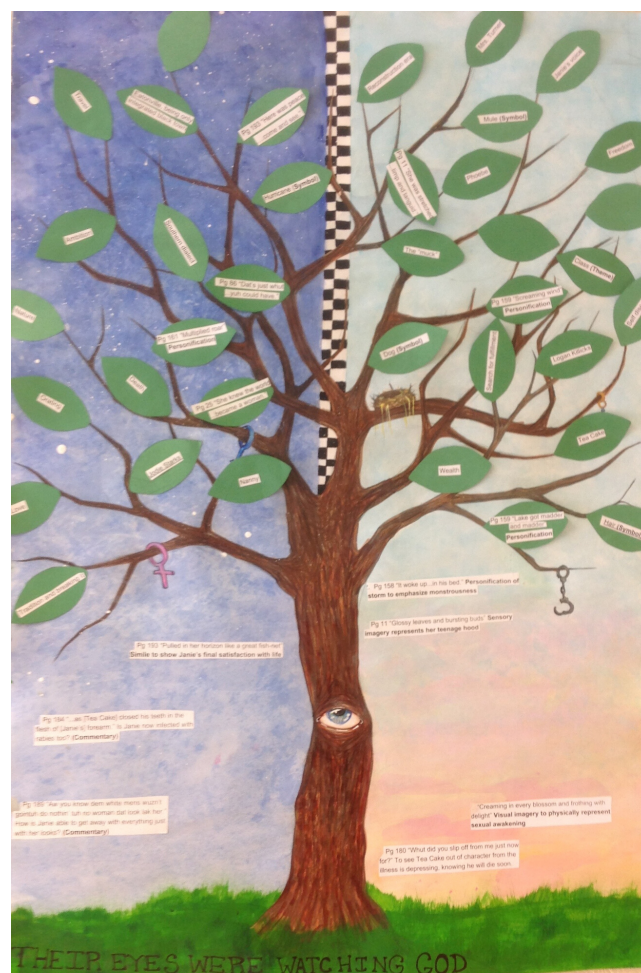
9th Grade CCCTC Make-up Work Sessions February 12th-13th
