

 - ❖ 2 classes through SVCC




- 9 internships completed or in progress

- ❖ 4 AP or Honors online classes completed or in progress






- ❖ Our graduating seniors have been offered collectively between \$1.9 and \$6.6 million <u>annually</u> in academic college scholarships.
- ❖ In 2019 the average scholarship package per graduate was \$59,375!
- ❖ 91% of our current seniors were accepted into their first-choice schools.
- ❖ Our students are accepted into a range of prestigious colleges and universities, including among others UVA, VA Tech, William and Mary, VMI, The United States Military College at West Point, University of Richmond, and Washington and Lee.








Flexible Tuition (cont.)

The what/why/how of Flexible Tuition at Fuqua School?

- ❖ What? Flexible Tuition is an "opt-in" program that aligns a family's tuition with their financial resources.
- ❖ Why? The purpose of Flexible Tuition is to make a Fuqua School education more accessible to a larger number of families in our community and to optimize enrollment thus reducing costs for all families.
- ❖ How? Simply enter your household income into the <u>tuition calculator</u> on the Fuqua School website to get a tuition estimate. To apply for Flexible Tuition complete the <u>FT Application through FACTS</u>.

Pre-kindergarten (Full Day)	\$3,500 - \$6,180
Lower School (Grades K-5)	\$3,500 - \$8,860

- ❖ Launch of Digital Marketing Campaign on February 1 to advertise Fuqua School and Flexible Tuition. Using Geofencing and Search Engine Marketing (SEM)
- ❖ Postcards mailed to prospective families advertising open houses and Flexible Tuition
- ❖ Word of mouth grab a flyer and spread the word!








2019-2020 Fuqua School Finances - Income






2019-2020 Fuqua School Finances - Expenses
