### Richland School Bond Passes!

#### **Historic Landslide Victory for Students**

A Tri-City hotel operator and commercial developer was the winning bidder for the Kennewick mansion built by former NHL star Olie Kolzig and his wife, Christin.

Gurbir Sandhu partnered with California investors to submit the winning bid of \$3.5 million for the mansion and the 95 acres of Horse Heaven Hills

countryside it sits on.

The property was the subject of a high-profile auction Oct. 5 by DeCaro Auctions.

The deal closed Oct. 31 but is not vet visible in the Benton County Assessor's public database of property information.

But Sandhu confirmed he is the new owner.

He intends to convert the mansion into a place for events and will develop the surrounding property into a subdivision with oversized lots of 3 to 5

acres each.

He has hired an architect to develop a site plan. Nearby home lots sell for \$400,000 to \$500,000, he said.

Sandhu is the managing partner for Insight Hotels, a Tri-City hotel firm that operates the Red Lion Columbia Center, the Richland Red Lion (soon to be Holiday Inn) and other properties across the Northwest.

He called the deal an opportu-

 Communicate committee recommendations to Board of Directors






