Minutes from last meeting approved

A. School Improvement Plan Reviewed

- I. Principal Kennett reviewed current expenditures and pointed out where cushions lie
 - Goal #2 – Paraprofessionals are attending CMI training along with teachers
 - There is money to support science instruction as we move to new standards
 - Tech needs remain; Smart Charging carts, microphone replacement
- II. CMI and Observation Data
 - Goal 1 met
 - Kristy Rogers has trained 100% of teachers and tutors working with students
 - 100% of teachers implementing routines with fidelity
 - Goal 2 well underway

- Teachers shared the impact CMI has had. Questions were asked regarding Common Core. CMI is intended to help teachers extend their own mathematical understanding of concepts Utah Core requires. This deeper understanding will help teachers teach more effectively in the future. Connections to Science roll-out were made.
- Data from this year's observations shared; 20% increase in enrichment, 100% of teachers are enriching students learning, 100% of teachers are differentiating to meet individual student needs.
- Year three there will be no grant money.
- Suggestion made that we take care of things like technology refresh now so that we can allot money in the future to fund supporting continuing with CMI
- Approximately \$10,000 needs to be re-allocated
- Council was tasked with reflecting on how to re-allocate these funds. Email Katie with ideas.
