



Varsity Volleyball Coaching Position

Job Description

The Academy of the Sacred Heart is seeking a **part-time Varsity volleyball coaching position**. The Varsity coach is directly accountable to the Athletic Director, and works with the Athletic Director and the Associate Athletic Director to ensure that the athletic program they are coaching reflects the *Goals and Criteria* of Sacred Heart education.

Responsibilities Include:

- Organizing and planning practices
- Communicating weekly schedules with parents and athletic department
- Inspiring confidence and modeling good sportsmanship
- Being a teacher of the game emphasizing skill development, fair play, and fun
- Able to attend all practices and games
- Hosting scrimmages, jamborees, tournaments
- Oversee the volleyball program and coordinate scheduling of all varsity and jv volleyball matches
- To work with the athletic department in arranging all transportation needs
- Any other tasks delegated by the Athletic Director and/or the Associate Athletic Director

Application Process

1. Cover letter indicating why they are particularly interested in and qualified for the position.
2. Current résumé.
