VIRTUAL SUMMER SCHOOL IMPORTANT DATES

- Online registration begins March 1st.
- Mail-In/Drop-Off registration begins Wednesday, March 11.
- Pre-registration ends Wednesday, June 10. Walk-in ends at 3:00pm and online ends at 11:00pm.
- After June 10th, registration for first session will continue starting June 15th, Mondays-Fridays from 8am-12pm until July 13th at the Boulan Park Middle School Summer School Office.
- Proctored final exams are on site in the Summer School Virtual Labs at Boulan Park Middle School.
- Students taking ONE virtual course must complete their final exam on or before July 28, 12pm.
- Students taking TWO virtual courses must complete their final exam for their first course by July 8, 12pm, and will not be allowed to begin their second course until that final exam is completed and recorded. If you have one virtual class and one in-seat class, your schedule may be different. You can start your virtual course while taking your in-seat course at the same time.
- Students taking TWO virtual courses must complete the final exam for their second course by July 30, 12pm.

Troy School District High School Summer School Description of Virtual Program

OVERVIEW:

Students will utilize online learning curricula to receive credits toward graduation. Instruction and assessment will be **online**. The final exam <u>must be taken on site</u> at Boulan Park Middle School in a computer lab. Credit for the course will be awarded upon successful completion. This program provides an option for those students who cannot attend in-seat High School Summer School available through Troy School District.

PROGRAM SCHEDULE:

- Virtual classes open June 16, 2020.
- Students may attend an optional orientation at Boulan Park Middle School FOR STUDENTS WHO REGISTER BY JUNE 10:

Optional orientation is June 16 at 12:30pm in the Virtual Lab room 509 at Boulan Park Middle School.

- All students will be provided log-in credentials and website address via email by June 15.
- Students who do not need to attend the orientation may begin their course on June 16.

FOR STUDENTS WHO REGISTER AFTER JUNE 10:

Optional orientation is June 17 at 10:00am in the Virtual Lab room 509 at Boulan Park Middle School.

- Classes will take an *average* of two hours per day for one class and four hours per day for two classes. Students will work to complete the selected curricula with due diligence during the scheduled program time.
- Proctored final exams are on site in the Summer School Virtual Lab at Boulan Park Middle School.
 - Students taking ONE virtual course must complete their final exam on or before July 28, 12:00pm.
 - Students taking TWO virtual courses must complete their final exam for their first course by July 8,
 12:00pm, and will not be allowed to begin their second course until that final exam is completed and
 recorded. If you have one virtual class and one in-seat class, your schedule may be different. You can
 start your virtual course while taking your in-seat course at the same time.
 - Students taking TWO virtual courses must complete the final exam for their second course by July 30,
 12:00pm.
- If a student is **not** staying on target to complete their class, they will be required to start coming into the lab from 8:00am-12:00pm Monday through Friday to catch up.
- The Virtual Lab will be available every Monday-Friday from 8:00am-12:00pm for additional support with a certified teacher. There will be no lab July 3.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

Students will be considered for the virtual program based on the recommendation of their administrator or guidance counselor. To register for the virtual program visit: www.troyceonline.com or mail/walk-in a completed application form to the Niles Center (201 W. Square Lake Road, Troy, MI 48098). The terms and conditions must be signed by the parent/guardian and student (on the back of the registration form) or mark the waiver online as approved by the parent/guardian. Failure to meet the terms and conditions of the contract may result in non-admittance or removal from the program.

REFUND/DROP/TRANSFER POLICY:

Refunds must be requested **either** before the first quiz is completed **or** before **July 17**, if no quiz has been taken. There is a \$20 processing fee per class for each refund or change requested. Once the class is 30% completed, a grade will be recorded, even if the class is dropped. This means an "E" will be reported if the class is not completed after the student reaches 30% completion.

In order to participate in the Troy School District Virtual Program, the student and parent/guardian agree to the following terms and conditions as indicated by signing below:

- 1) The student will work to complete the selected curricula with due diligence during the scheduled program time. Staying on target with timelines is the key to success. If the student falls behind, the student agrees to come to the Virtual Lab at Boulan Park Middle School between 8:00am and 12:00pm, Monday through Friday, to catch up.
- 2) The student must take the Final Exam for each class in the Virtual Lab at Boulan Park Middle between the hours of 8am to 12pm, Monday through Friday until Thursday, July 30 (see front page for exam deadlines for one and two classes). Be sure to give yourself enough time to complete the final exam by 12pm. <u>Under no circumstance will a student be allowed to take their final exam after Thursday, July 30, 12pm.</u> Any student who is unable to take their final exam, or does not show up for the exam at the scheduled time, will receive a zero on the exam and will receive a grade that includes that score in their final average.
- 3) The student agrees to abide by all TSD acceptable use policies while working on school district computers and/or software. Failure to abide by these policies may result in loss of computer privileges and dismissal from the program.
- 4) The student and parent/guardian understand that there will be no refunds once a student completes the first quiz or after July 17, if no quiz has been taken. Once the class is 30% completed, an "E" grade will be recorded, even if the class is dropped.
