Meeting minutes from December 4th were reviewed and approved

Review of crosswalk by Kindergarten doors being painted- Diane Ramsey has requested it from the district, as of today it is not done. Brooke Pendleton is doing a follow up phone call.

New playground program reviewed, coaches (students) have been assigned and equipment has been purchased. Program will begin February 3rd.

Current budget was reviewed

Data

High points: mid year DIBELS data K-3 is 66% has seen a steady growth from 46% in the 2016-2017 school year

Possible outcome of this increase is the Early/Next Steps training and teachers went to and implemented. Teachers stated that the program is "amazing".

Low Points: Numbers base to 10, 3-6th grade is at 60% mastery. Math data from RISE is not accurate. There were too many errors in testing and so data is skewed. Students with Disabilities has been made a "target support". The growth of those with IEP's has not been as much as other students.

Ideas for 2020-2021 money

- keep tutors from this year and add two more to help with the "target support" and try to keep SPED kids in the classroom more than the pullout method.
- technology funds-renewal of devices and projectors etc.
- professional development from Early/Next Steps training
